THE CARRIAGE OF ALL DANGEROUS GOODS, INCLUDING THOSE OF IMO HAZARD CLASS 7 WHICH ARE NOT COVERED BY SOLAS 74, REGULATION II-54, MUST BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS AND LIMITATIONS OF THE CURRENT EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL MARITIME DANGEROUS GOODS (IMDG) CODE FOR THE SPECIFIC DANGEROUS GOODS, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN 49 CFR 176.11.
