The following high water operating requirements have been implemented:

ADM Grain AMA

For safety reasons, ADM Grain AMA will require two line-handling crews for all mooring/unmooring's until such time as the river level is reduced and the flow slows.
This restriction is issued in the interest of safety of all concerned and effective Immediately. (This applies only to the ADM AMA location.)
