Did not want to give personal information.

Routine trip to docking terminal.

At time of crash. Lower deck, Port side, 2nd row of seats from the left side of the ferry, seated in the last seat of the row. In front of the bar.

Just prior to crash, in seat. Got up to throw out garbage. Garbage pail just behind me. I got up and turned right after getting up and turning.

I did not notice anything unusual speed or anything.

Thrown backward, landed flat on back on the deck.

Passenger told me to stay where you are. Remained there for 10 or 15 minutes till emergency responders removed passengers.

Helped to passenger chair. By passenger who had helped him and stayed with you.

Removed by board. Placed collar around neck.

EMS ambulance, one other injured. Yes. Examined head and neck-no injuries. Without catscan performed. Bruises on body. For several days sore and achy.

Crew does a good job of trying to ensure. They make announcements while the vessel is underway. Safety issue.

Open doors on front – Could wait up to 10 minutes. Summer time –more people upstairs, longer to get out. People can only get off one at a time. Rear exit door. Several lines of people lined up to get out.

Saw buildings off to left. Did not notice approach to terminal. I was reading. Pretty routine.

Not aware of any signs telling people to remain in seats.

Noticed that seats were empty. Habit to ride in same seat.
