WHILE OWN VESSEL WAS ANCHORED (WITH TWO ANCHOR & AT BELMONT ANCHORAGE NOLA, USA (POSITION: LAT: 30-00.732 N, LONG: 090-46.997 W) AND AWAITING FOR BERTHING SCHEDULE 0700 LT / 18 JANUARY 2016. HEREBY STATES IMPORTANT FACTS WITH ABOVE INCIDENT AS FOLLOWS: - OTHER VESSEL AND MANEUVERED HEADING 160T WITH SPEED OF ABOUT 3 KNOTS. UNFORTUNATELY, OTHER VESSEL STRUCK THE STBD ACHOR THEN CAUGHT AT PORTSIDE ANCHOR. SHE THEN SWING OUT TO PORT SIDE AND HIT THE PORT BOW OF OWN VESSEL. - MASTER IMMEDIATELY CALL THE ATTENTION OF ALL CONCERNED (DECK & ENGINE 1631 PERSONNEL) TO STANDBY. 1636 - STANDBY ENGINE 1640 - CHIEF OFFICER ADVISED TO CREW MEMBERS TO SOUNDING ALL BALLAST TANK / CHECKED CARGO HOLDS CONDITION AND OIL SPILLAGE. 1643 FROM PORT SIDE ANCHOR CHAIN OF OWN VESSEL. 1657 1716 - PILOT ON BOARD. CAPT. CHAD V. CEFALU #78 1725 - HEAVED UP STARBOARD ANCHOR AND AND HULL. THE EXTENT OF THE DAMAGED WAS NOT CONFIRMED AT THIS TIME. 1730 - STARTED HEAVING PORT SIDE ANCHOR. 1740 - ANCHOR AWEIGH / VESSEL STARTED SHIFTING 1745 - CONFIRMED NO WATER INGRESS AND OIL SPILLAGES. 1750 - TUG'S MADE FAST STBD SIDE SHOULDER. TUG BOAT "SCOTT T. SLATTEN" 1753 -DROPPED PORT SIDE ANCHOR 4 SHACKLES IN THE WATER. 1825 - FINISHED WITH ENGINE NO INJURY HAPPENED, AND FUTHERMORE, NO MARINE POLLUTION
