



Subject: Accident Investigation DCA18MM028

On October 12, 2018, at approximately 1430 eastern daylight time (EDT), Mr. Mike Richards of the National Transportation Safety Board and Mr. Kelsey Angle of the National Weather Service had a telephone conversation with Weather Decision Technologies, Inc. (WDT). During the conversation WDT reported the following:

WDT creates two WSR-88D weather radar mosaics that are provided to Earth Networks: (1) a "low altitude" mosaic and (2) a "composite" mosaic. The composite mosaic is based on Level II WSR-88D data and has a resolution of 0.01x0.01 latitude/longitude or roughly 1-km. WDT is constantly receiving Level II data from the WSR-88D weather radar network in the United States on a scan-by-scan (tilt-by-tilt) basis. Once received, each scan undergoes a quality control (QC) process which removes non-precipitation targets based on dual polarization information received from the radar. This QC process takes about 1 minute per individual radar scan. Every 5 minutes, beginning at the top of the hour (i.e., at time steps of :00, :05, :10, :15, etc, minutes past each hour), a composite mosaic creation process is started. For each individual grid point within the mosaic's geographic domain, only data from radars positioned within 300 kilometers of that grid point are able to contribute to the composite mosaic at that grid point. Radar data from every scan from each contributing radar over that grid point is considered and the highest value of reflectivity from those scans over that grid point is used for the final two-dimensional composite mosaic product at that grid point. During conversion from a polar coordinate system to a cartesian coordinate system for the final two-dimensional composite mosaic product, interpolation occurs that changes the effective spatial resolution. WDT does apply minor smoothing (using a percentile smoother) to the composite mosaic. Once the final composite mosaic product is created it is deposited into the local data manager (LDM) and transmitted to Earth Networks. The average time between the start of the composite mosaic creation process to the time the final composite mosaic product is made available to Earth Networks via the LDM is roughly one minute.

The grid point within the mosaic domain near Table Rock Lake considered contribution from five different WSR-88D weather radars.

The time that the composite mosaic creation process is started is considered that mosaic's "valid time." Using this valid time is considered the "industry standard" for timestamping weather radar mosaics. The time stamp associated with the individual QC'ed composite mosaics created by WDT and requested by the NTSB is that mosaic's valid time. Considering average composite mosaic creation process times, and delivery time to the LDM, Earth Networks would have access to final WDT composite mosaics about one minute after their valid times [assuming WDT and Earth Networks' clocks are synchronized²].

The QC process applied to the Level II WSR-88D weather radar data used in the composite mosaic creation process, which removes non-precipitation echoes, is done so in response to WDT's customers' demand for "clean" precipitation products. WDT has been producing composite mosaic products for customers for over 14 years and this strategy has been applied throughout that time. WDT has received feedback that radar products that include non-precipitation targets can be misinterpreted and are not desired by customers and end-users.

¹ On October 12, 2018, the NTSB requested graphical representations of the final composite mosaics with valid times surrounding the accident time made available to Earth Networks.

² In later correspondence, WDT indicated that they use "...Network Time Protocol [NTP] for clock synchronization between all servers as provided by default through AWS. NTP synchronizes all servers to within a few milliseconds of Coordinated Universal Time (UTC)."

It is the lowest layer in the 3D mosaic grid. Typically it would be the lowest elevation angle from radars but there are cases where there could be blockage at the lowest angle and thus a higher elevation is considered (depending on distance from the radar)...the important part is that we create a 3D grid of the radar data and the low-altitude is the lowest altitude level with valid data (not terrain blocked), so it is terrain following.

On August 9, 2018, at approximately 1300 eastern daylight time (EDT), Mr. Mike Richards of the National Transportation Safety Board and Mr. Kelsey Angle of the National Weather Service had a telephone conversation with Earth Networks. During the conversation Earth Networks reported the following:

The exact time that surface observations are acquired from Unisys by Earth Networks cannot be determined (receipt is not time-stamped). With regard to the 19 July 2018 FWB METAR time-stamped 2355Z, the METAR would have appeared in the Earth Networks alerting system sometime after 1906:44 CDT on 19 July 2018 but before 1910:51 on 19 July 2018. Prior to the METAR entering the Earth Networks alerting system, the METAR goes through an internal "QC" process. Once surface observation data are received by Unisys, a "scheduler" picks it up. A scheduler is launched every 5 minutes (or sooner) to process any new alert that was triggered by the customer's alert rules.

There are no Earth Networks surface stations within the 20-statute mile radius surrounding the State Park Marina point defined by Ride The Ducks Branson in their account. The only surface observation stations available within that radius are FWB and BBG. It is possible that a station may be generally available within StreamerRT, but at any given time might not be plotted if data from that station has been "flagged."

The email addresses Earth Networks sends alerts to are defined by the customer. Differences between email addresses associated with the Ride The Ducks Branson account that alerts were sent to on 19 July 2018, and email addresses documented in the "Branson - Ride the Ducks Entity


and Alert Setup" pdf [provided to the NTSB by Earth Networks], would be due to customer-initiated account changes, not by Earth Networks.
