3	MICHAEL KARR: This is Mike Karr of the
4	National Transportation Safety Board. It's 1830 on
5	August 21st, 2016, and we are in the conference room at
6	Sector San Juan, conducting an interview regarding the
7	Caribbean Fantasy fire.
8	I would like to go around the table and have
9	everybody introduce themselves by name and their
LO	organization.
L1	United States Coast
L2	Guard.
L3	CARRIE BELL: Carrie Bell, NTSB.
L4	DANTE DelRosario: My name is Dante
L5	DelRosario, I'm the food manager of the Caribbean
L6	Fantasy.
L7	U.S. Coast Guard.
L8	MICHAEL KARR: All right. And, sir do you
L9	mind if we record the interview?
20	DANTE DELROSARIO: No problem.
21	MICHAEL: Okay. Thank you very much. So if
22	you
23	would, first tell me briefly describe your main job
24	onboard the ship, how long you've been with the ship.
25	DANTE DELROSARIO: I joined the ship,
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Caribbean Fantasy on the 5th of August, so the time when the accident happened, that's my 12th day -- I am 12 days on board. And as a food manager I am in charge of the food, the restaurant operation and the provisions, plus the kitchen operations. Although under me we have the sous-chef who is directly, I mean, working with the cooks, and the head waiter, plus the store keeper. So.

MICHAEL KARR: All right, thanks. And, can you tell us -- go to the morning of the fire.

DANTE DELROSARIO: Okay.

MICHAEL KARR: Can you tell us about your morning?

DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes. That morning when, you know, the day-to-day thing is to check because prior to arrival to San Juan where we're always doing general cleaning the night before. So that morning we were doing some sort of inspection for engage with SPH. We'll, you know, and suddenly I heard this Mr. Skylight announcement that was, I think it was 7:30. And we were still busy with the inspection with our sanitation officer, so we just carried on.

And then when we reached the restaurant which is close to the reception, the hotel director told me that we have to -- I have to inform the people

to evacuate the restaurant and the crew mess and the dining room, so that's what I did. And then after that I saw many passengers already running upstairs. was around, maybe, just a few minutes before 8:00. MICHAEL KARR: And continue. Just tell me about your morning. DANTE DELROSARIO: So, I saw the chief purser, she's also running around asking for people to help her carry the crew passports and some cash from her boat, so I helped her and at the same time we are leading the passengers to go to the upper deck, which is the Master Station, the embarkation deck, and that's I helped the chief purser getting the passports from Deck 5 to Deck 7. Maybe I carrying two box of crew passports, sir. And that's it. That's all I remember. MICHAEL KARR: Did you stay with the chief purser? DANTE DELROSARIO: No, actually I stayed the whole time because of the money and the crew passports. we had already on Deck 7. MICHAEL KARR: All right, well tell me when you were with -- until you got to Deck 7, was there any time that you encountered smoke? DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, there was.

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1 the chimney, I mean, pull up smoke or -- and even on 2 that deck, which is the open deck, which is Deck 7, and smoke was coming out from the chimney, black smoke, 3 white and --4 5 MICHAEL KARR: All right. And tell us how 6 you evacuated the vessel. 7 DANTE DELROSARIO: We were the last. 8 Actually, I think there were only 30 or 40 people left 9 when I disembarked, and still I am getting the whole 10 passports and the money with the chief purser. MICHAEL KARR: So did you go down the MES? 11 12 DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, we got on the slide, 13 that side. MICHAEL KARR: 14 Aha. DANTE DELROSARIO: And then from the life raft we were 15 16 transferred to the Coast Guard boat and then they 17 brought us to the terminal. MICHAEL KARR: All right. During the time that you 18 19 were on the boat, did you hear or notice anyone getting 20 injured? 21 DANTE DELROSARIO: Actually, I saw one crew I think he's a security officer. 22 member. 23 MICHAEL KARR: All right. 24 DANTE DELROSARIO: Because once they reach 25 the life raft, the life raft was shaking and the Coast

1	Guard's trying to help them move to several vessels and
2	move from the life raft to their vessels. So, but I
3	saw one, I think one of the security of the ship.
4	MICHAEL KARR: Yes. Can you describe how
5	you got from the platform onto the Coast Guard boat?
6	DANTE DELROSARIO: I mean, you know, we used
7	the slide and then reaching the life raft of the ship
8	and the Coast Guard is trying to go near the life raft
9	so we were so that way. And the life raft, to Coast
10	Guard.
11	MICHAEL KARR: Were you able to step
12	DANTE DELROSARIO: We jumped from
13	MICHAEL KARR: You jumped?
14	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, from the side of I
15	mean from the corner of the life raft to the Coast
16	Guard boat.
17	MICHAEL KARR: Was the Coast Guard boat
18	higher than the life raft?
19	DANTE DELROSARIO: A bit higher than the
20	life raft I believe it's big, a bit higher.
21	MICHAEL KARR: Okay.
22	DANTE DELROSARIO: And I think that's it.
23	We went to the terminal. We were four in that Coast
24	Guard boat.
25	MICHAEL KARR: Pardon me?

1 DANTE DELROSARIO: We were four people -- I 2 mean, there are four crew. MICHAEL KARR: Okay, four crew. Were there 3 4 passengers on the Coast Guard boat? 5 DANTE DELROSARIO: No, no, no passengers because 6 the time we disembarked there were no passengers aboard 7 the --8 MICHAEL KARR: All right. And the Coast Guard boat that brought you ashore, was it the same one 9 that picked you up off the platform, the raft? 10 DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes. 11 12 MICHAEL KARR: Okay. DANTE DELROSARIO: Actually, I think they 13 14 were planning to transfer us to a bigger boat. 15 then later on they said, no we are able to take you 16 directly to the terminal. 17 MICHAEL KARR: All right. DANTE DELROSARIO: And I saw some crew 18 19 transferred to bigger boats, from that boat to the 20 bigger boat, but not us. We went directly from the 21 life raft, to Coast Guard boat and directly to the 22 terminal. 23 MICHAEL KARR: Yes. And how did -- what did -- did you notice any -- well, describe to me the 24 25 behavior of the passengers while they were waiting to

1 be evacuated. 2 DANTE DELROSARIO: I think because the slide is very steep, some of them, the ones who remained to 3 use the slide is even they were a bit panicked, but 4 5 there was no shouting. The staff captain came and disembarked them, you know, because of the steep slide. 6 7 And it's dangerous to -- I mean, if you look at the the 8 slide, you know, it's standing like -- so it takes some time for the remaining passengers to disembark or to go 9 to the slide to slide down. 10 How did you get the --11 MICHAEL KARR: Yes. 12 how does one get this injury from the --13 DANTE DELROSARIO: From the, you know, the 14 slide you have to hold and --MICHAEL KARR: So you're holding it like 15 16 this? 17 DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes. MICHAEL KARR: 18 Okay. 19 DANTE DELROSARIO: Especially like carrying 20 the crew passport, it's heavy, you're talking 100 21 something passports and seaman's book in plastic bags. 22 So I have to hold that. Otherwise I will stumble and -23 All right. 24 MICHAEL KARR:

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Guard. First of all, I'd like to congratulate you on a successful evacuation of the ship.

DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, thank you.

That's a very large undertaking. So your job is essentially to evacuate all the areas on the vessel where people would eat? Restaurants --

DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, actually per my safety card, my duty is in the crew mess area -- to evacuate the crew, people from the crew mess area to the Master's Station, to disembarkation. But that day, since I was in the kitchen and restaurant doing the inspection, I was asked by the hotel director that I have to evacuate -- I mean, actually I have to clear the passengers and to show them the way to the reception to go out to the Master Station.

And the hotel director directed you to do that?

DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, with the rest of the restaurant guys. I mean, I was with the restaurant guys. The rest of the Group A was still open at that time. We opened the Group A at 6:00 and it will run until 10:00. So there were a few passengers having breakfast. Not many, but approximately 15, 20 passengers.

1	Okay. So if you were under the
2	direction of the hotel director, evacuating the
3	passengers from where again? I apologize.
4	DANTE DELROSARIO: The restaurant.
5	The restaurant and assisting
6	the chief purser with passports, who who was evacuating
7	the crew mess area?
8	DANTE DELROSARIO: I was. Still actually
9	the smoke was coming from the crew area, going inside
10	the galley, then through the restaurant, so at that
11	time we cleared already the whole mess area.
12	There was nobody there because I think the
13	engine room I am not sure because I told you I am
14	only 12 days. But the smoke was coming from that area,
15	so and crew mess was closed already, there is no
16	operation. It's closed because we are already in the
17	Pilot's Station and breakfast is served only until
18	7:30, so we were closed. So only that was
19	So what areas were filled with
20	smoke?
21	DANTE DELROSARIO: Come again?
22	Did I understand you correctly
23	when you said the crew mess there was smoke in the
24	crew mess?
25	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, while we were doing

1 the 2 inspection inside the galley because crew mess is connected to the main galley and the main galley is 3 connected to the restaurant, so the smoke was coming 4 5 from that area, from the crew mess area, going inside 6 the galley. And, again, from the galley inside the 7 restaurant, so, because they are all connected. 8 All right. 9 DANTE DELROSARIO: They are on one floor, 10 one floor connected there. So smoke was going from the 11 12 crew mess --13 DANTE DELSARIO: At the beginning it was 14 just ---- into the main galley --15 16 DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes. 17 And then from the main galley into the -- is there only one main restaurant? 18 19 Yes, there is only one. DANTE DELROSARIO: 20 What is the size of the 21 restaurant? 22 DANTE DELROSARIO: A small one. At that time 23 there were less than 20 people. Again, I don't know exactly how many, but I know less than 20 people are 24 25 having breakfast.

1	Okay. When you arrived on
2	shore after the Coast Guard boat dropped you off ashore
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4	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes.
5	how did the shore side
6	personnel account for you?
7	DANTE DELROSARIO: On arrival? I arrived
8	by, we stepped on the, on the boat. Yes.
9	So you step from the boat,
10	on the pier and from the first step from the
11	boat on the pier. And
12	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, somebody is helping them,
13	removing their life jacket, removing the life jacket
14	So from your first step on the
15	pier, walk me through that process.
16	DANTE DELROSARIO: So they asked us to
17	remove the life jacket, the life vest, so and ask if
18	are you all right or do you feel something like
19	because one of the guys with me was taken by the
20	doctors I don't know, he was taken by the doctor
21	because he was feeling sick.
22	So from there we were asked to board the bus
23	and we were taken to the terminal building. At the
24	terminal building the chief purser, I was with her, and
25	she has one crew list and started to do some roll call.

1	Okay. Who met you on the dock?
2	DANTE DELROSARIO: Some I don't
3	Was it Coast Guard?
4	DANTE DELROSARIO: I don't remember, Coast
5	Guard or medics. There were many people there
6	actually.
7	When you first got off the
8	Coast Guard boat
9	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, there were many
10	before you got on the bus.
11	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, there were many.
12	And they lined up and asking if you are all right, but
13	I don't know. There were wearing blue, white and some
14	medics. Some typical water
15	So you don't know if they were company
16	representatives, they were crew from the ship?
17	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes some company
18	representatives also, but I don't remember and since I
19	am new I don't remember. I know they were wearing red
20	shirt red shirts. Some people were giving out
21	water. So I boarded the bus, we were taken to the
22	terminal building and from there they started
23	distributing drinks and water and
24	Well, how were you accounted
25	for at the terminal besides, you said the chief purser
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1	had a list and she was she was taking roll of the
2	people that were coming off the bus?
3	DANTE DELROSARIO: As people were driving
4	up, yes.
5	Okay.
6	DANTE DELROSARIO: As they were coming
7	inside the terminal.
8	Okay. And once the chief
9	purser accounted for you, you went inside the terminal
10	building?
11	DANTE DELROSARIO: Actually, we were already
12	sitting in the terminal building when she started
13	checking the names.
14	Okay, so you went off the bus
15	and directly into the terminal building, there was no
16	accountability between the bus and the terminal
17	building?
18	DANTE DELROSARIO: No, yes, that's correct.
19	CARRIE BELL: Carrie Bell, NTSB. I just have
20	a couple of questions. Since you didn't start you
21	didn't join the ship until 12 days before so did you
22	have any kind of familiarization training?
23	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, I started my ship
24	board career in 1989, so I have some experience
25	onboard. I used to work on a passenger ship. I've

1	been on Albatross (inaudible)
2	CARRIE BELL: Yes.
3	DANTE DELROSARIO: Ocean Cruise Lines as
4	food and beverage mangers, as chief purser, as food
5	controller.
6	CARRIE BELL: So you had several years of
7	experience?
8	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes ma'am.
9	CARRIE BELL: But this is the first time
10	you've been on this ship, correct? And so did you have
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12	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, this is the first
13	control.
14	CARRIE BELL: Okay, and so did you have any
15	kind of specific training to this ship when you got on
16	it?
17	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, when I first came on
18	board I did familiarization with the safety officer,
19	that's the time where she gave me the safety card, what
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	is your specific duty in case of an emergency. And
21	is your specific duty in case of an emergency. And during the familiarization she took me around to show

1	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, because that's the
2	first thing I think the crew needs to know, where is
3	your what is your duty in case of an emergency,
4	where is the Master Station, the embarkation, boat
5	embarkation.
6	CARRIE BELL: Okay.
7	DANTE DELROSARIO: And the exits, that's the
8	most important.
9	CARRIE BELL: Yes. Thank you. That's all I
10	have.
11	DANTE DELROSARIO: Okay.
12	MICHAEL KARR: All right.
13	Nothing, please.
14	I have one more follow up
15	question.
16	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes.
17	Did you receive any specific
18	training by the safety office or anyone else on how
19	let me go back one second. What is your title on your
20	safety card? You are the
21	DANTE DELROSARIO: I am the assistant life
22	raft
23	No, for general emergency.
24	DANTE DELROSARIO: My station is in the crew
25	mess
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1	So you are the crew mess
2	evacuation leader?
3	DANTE DELROSARIO: Actually I am not the
4	leader of the crew mess.
5	No, you are the crew mess
6	evacuation deputy leader?
7	DANTE DELROSARIO: Something like that
8	What's your safety number?
9	DANTE DELROSARIO: 52.
10	52, okay. So
11	DANTE DELROSARIO: I have to double check
12	first.
13	It's okay. Did you receive any
14	specific training
15	DANTE DELROSARIO: 51, sorry.
16	51? Do you mind if I take a
17	picture of that?
18	CARRIE BELL: Is that your safety card? Can
19	I take a look please?
20	Did you receive any specific
21	training? Let the recorder show that Dante is showing
22	us his safety card at the table right now, so we can
23	see what it looks like.
24	DANTE DELROSARIO: I just wanted to check.
25	MICHAEL KARR: Oh, want to take a picture,
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1	or Xerox.
2	DANTE DELROSARIO: I don't know because this
3	is Is that okay with you.
4	DANTE DELROSARIO: No, this is the safety
5	card that I emergencey safety card that I had
6	received onboard, so
7	CARRIE BELL: Is this what all crew members
8	receive?
9	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes.
10	CARRIE BELL: All the safety cards look like
11	that?
12	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, but with, in IB
13	jacket and the standard release, although I remove mine
14	from
15	Right, keep it safe. So my
16	follow up question would be based on that. Did you
17	receive by the safety officer or anyone else onboard
18	prior to being given that card, any training on how to
19	do that job?
20	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes, I told you the above
21	familiarization.
22	Well, the familiarization tells
23	you, you know
24	DANTE DELROSARIO: Which station
25	what kind of fire

1	extinguishers you have, what to do in a man overboard,
2	those kinds of things. Did you receive specific
3	training on how to be a crew mess evacuation team
4	member, or whatever safety number 51 is entailed?
5	DANTE DELROSARIO: During the
6	familiarization, she showed me where I should be during
7	emergency. I mean, my specific duty.
8	So she physically took you down
9	to the crew mess and said this is where you go and then
10	she explained to you this is how you evacuate the area?
11	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes.
12	Okay. Thank you very much. How
13	long do you think the entire familiarization lasted on
14	your first day, with everything that the
15	DANTE DELROSARIO: Actually we are 15 and we
16	took 2 and a half hours. There were 15 of us, including
17	she collected the certificates because that was during
18	our first day. She collected all training
19	certificates. I mean, we are 12, so it took at least 2
20	and a half hours to complete the familiarization.
21	So you did the familiarization
22	with up to 12 other crew members all at the same time?
23	DANTE DELROSARIO: All at the same time.
24	And did the safety officer give
25	each of the 12 people specific training to their safety
	I

2	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes.
3	The way she did yours?
4	DANTE DELROSARIO: Yes.
5	In that group setting. And
6	that's why it took so long.
7	DANTE DELROASRIO: It took some time.
8	That's all I have.
9	MICHAEL KARR: Anyone else? Any last
10	comments form you Dante?
11	DANTE DELROSARIO: No, no.
12	MICHAEL KARR: Well, it is 18:49 and I will
13	stop the recording.
