Per your request for information letter dated April 17, 2001, the following information is provided from AVN-100.

A copy of my PowerPoint presentation is being provided on a CD disk format. The supporting documentation that shows staffing/funding on AVN maintenance of flight procedures from 1994 to present is attached. This document shows the information from 1996 to the present. The information for 1994 and 1995 is not available because during that time frame the flight procedures program was a part of the Flight Operations Division, AVN-200. The flight procedures piece of the funding and staffing for this period cannot be separated from the overall AVN-200 figures.

The system used for tracking instrument flight procedures work is called PC Log. This is a computer-based system and requires manual input of data. As instrument flight procedures are added or deleted from the NAS, any work done on those procedures is recorded in this system. The system was a Superbase program until December 1998. It was then changed to an Access program. When the system was converted, any log entry older than one year that was not actively being worked, was not carried over to the new There are no existing historical files from the old Superbase program.

No waivers to criteria exist on this procedure. There is no TERPS criteria that addresses high MDA procedures.
