CONTROLLER AT AID AT TIME OF N827CM ACCIDENT

AT APPROXMITTLEY 2005Z (3:05 LCL) N827CM TAXIED TO RWY 18 AT ANDERSON (AID) AIRPORT. HE ASKED TO DEPART TO THE SOUTH FOR A TEST FLIGHT. I APPROVED AN ON COURSE DEPARTURE AND CLEARED HIM FOR TAKE-OFF. I LAST OBSERVED N827CM ABOUT TWO (2) MILES SOUTH OF ANDERSON AIRPORT CLIMBING IN A NORMAL ATTITUDE.

AT ABOUT 2018Z (3:18 LCL) THE TOWER WAS ADVISED BY AIRPORT MANGER, MR. STEVE DARLINGTON THAT A PLANE HAD CRASHED SOUTH OF ANDERSON. I MADE SEVERAL BLIND CALLS TO N827CM BUT NO RESPONSE. IT WAS LATER CONFORMED THAT N827CM WAS INDEED THE AIRCRAFT IN QUESTION.
