

# Amtrak Police Department Report

## Vandalism- Stoning Incidents 2012- May 18, 2015

Location: MP 81.7 PHLE Frankford Junction (5 mile radius)

In looking at stoning's within 5 miles of the derailment site, the following reports were gleaned:

1. Incident #: 12-005718 occurred on May 18, 2012 at 15:52 hours, Milepost 86.0 PHLE; Unknown suspects threw stones at Acela train # 2168 causing damage to the exterior of 2 windows.
2. Incident #: 13-009508 occurred on July 8, 2013 at 20:56 Milepost 81.0 PHLE; unknown suspects threw stones at Acela train 2126 at Milepost 81.0 PHLE causing damage to the café car window.
3. Incident #: 13-010992 occurred on August 9, 2013 at 19:21 hours, MP 85.0 PHLE; 2 black male juveniles threw stones at Acela train 2119 at MP 85.1 PHLE causing a fist sized break to a window in the middle of the train car.
4. Incident #: 14-003677 occurred on March 23, 2014 at 21:18 hours Milepost 79.4 PHLE; units responded to assist Philly PD on a report of shots fired. Upon arrival the units were advised by a Philly Sgt. that there were 6 spent .40 caliber casings located approximately 20 yards from the tracks at MP 79.4 PHLE. No suspects were located.
5. Incident #: 14-004918 occurred on April 18, 2014 at 21:18 hours, Milepost 84.5 PHLE; a bicycle was thrown from an overpass onto the top of Acela train 2175 at Milepost 84.5 PHLE causing damage to the pantograph.
6. Incident #: 15-002787 occurred on March 4, 2015 at 17:13 hours Holms Interlocking; Acela train 2170 was stoned by unknown subjects in the area of Holmes Interlocking Milepost 77.0 PHLE. One of the windows of the third car from the headend was cracked as a result.
7. Incident #: 15-005910 occurred on May 12, 2015 at 21:23 hours, 5 minutes East of PHL station; the window of the third car of Acela train 2173 was hit by an unknown object causing it to crack and break approximately 5 minutes prior to arriving in PHL. R/P reported it was too dark to see any subject who may have thrown something at the train.
8. Event #: 15-1320487 occurred on May 12, 2015 at 21:22hours, Milepost 86.0 PHLE; A call for service was received for juveniles throwing stones at SEPTA train # 769. The windshield was shattered and EMS was requested for the engineer.

\*No arrests were in any of the above incidents.

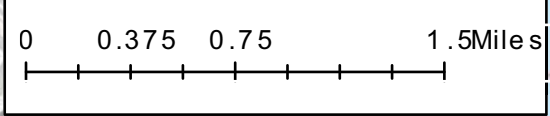

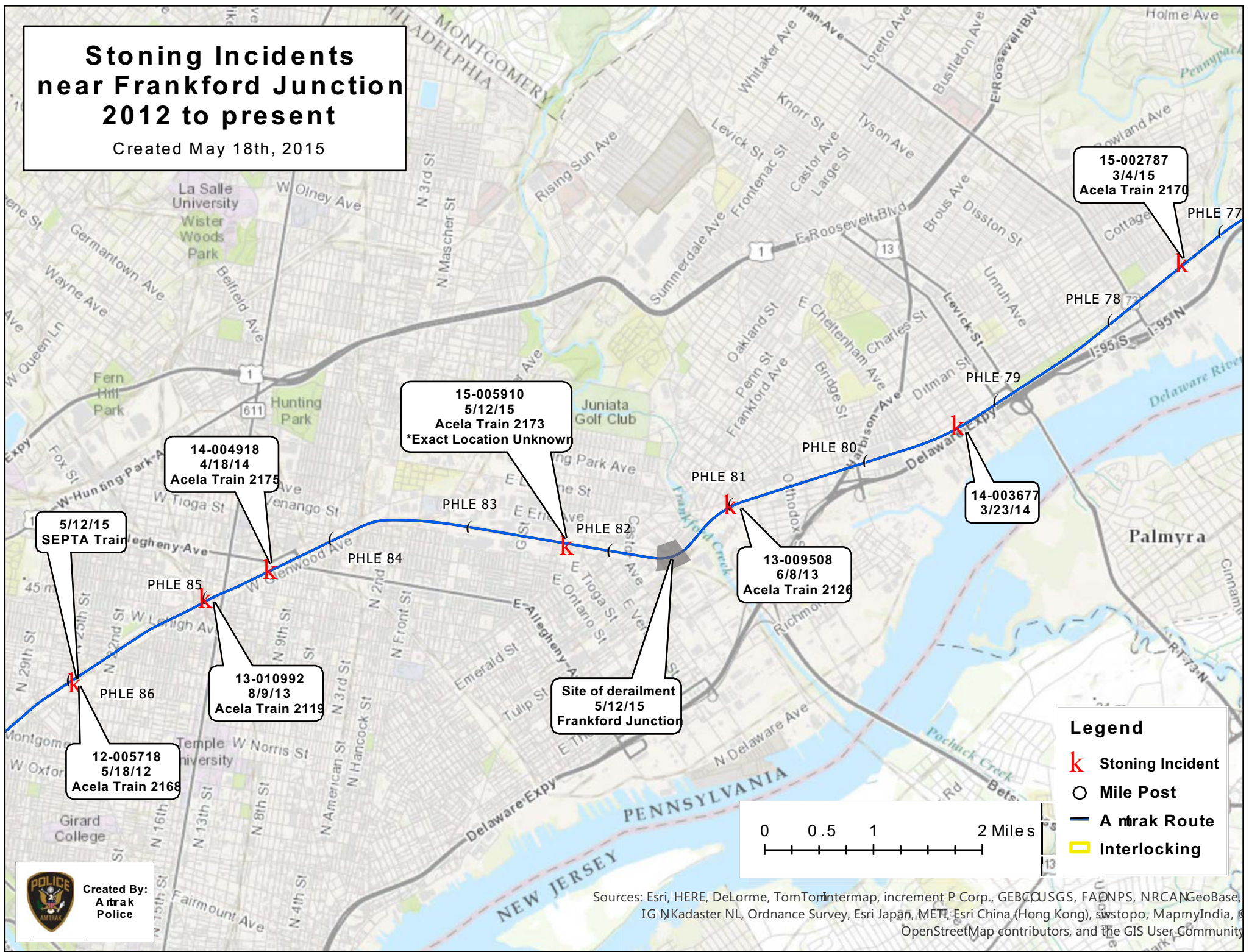

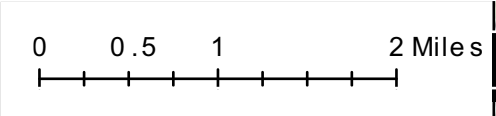
# Stoning Incidents near Frankford Junction 2012 to present
