I just did an internet search to see if there is any other public documentation about the CSIG movement and didn't find anything. On occasion when the thunderstorm cells contained in the CSIG are moving in vastly different direction than the CSIG, we add a comment at the bottom of the CSIG something like "CELL MOV FROM 22040KT". Of course, we don't include all comment options in the NWS Directives, so most people don't know this.
