Re: Bus # 5278/ 1-3 accident Fatality

At scene at Bus Stop on Houston and Avenue D bus shelter eastbound stop, a witness Named Steven Crespo [REDACTED] Brooklyn NY 11237.

Mr. Crespo stated that while on bus, he got out of seat and asked operator if that particular bus went on or around Essex street, as operator was making the turn from Avenue D onto Houston Street, operator responded by stating that he needed the M14A, he was facing forward by partition and fare box as he was asking operator for directions.

Bus was in motion and as bus was making left turn, he noticed a female pedestrian crossing street not on side walk but left of bus, she appeared to be running next to bus, As bus was entering street from turn, he saw her crossing in front of bus, he yelled to operator "watch out there is a lady crossing street"

The lady disappeared under the bus and operator tried his best to avoid pedestrian to no avail.
