### Dear Custodian of Records:

Enclosed please find a subpoena issued by the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) for any and all call activity (time of call, duration of call, and number) for both incoming and outgoing calls; and SMS message activity (time of message, origination, and destination) for both incoming and outgoing SMS messages, occurring between May 22, 2009, up to and including June 22, 2009, for cellular telephone number (716) 553-9713. The phone associated with this number was owned by a crewmember involved in the above-referenced accident.

Please note that while we are not currently seeking the actual textual content of any SMS messages, we ask that you preserve any such records in accordance with our preservation request made on June 23, 2009.

Under the Independent Safety Board Act, as amended, the NTSB is responsible for the investigation of, among other things, all civil aviation accidents, fatal rail accidents, and accidents involving other transportation modes. 49 U.S.C. § 1131. The statute may be viewed on our website, <a href="http://www.ntsb.gov/alj/NTSB\_statute.htm">http://www.ntsb.gov/alj/NTSB\_statute.htm</a>. To carry out its responsibilities, the NTSB determines the probable cause or causes of certain accidents and makes recommendations for the improvement of safety, with the ultimate goal of preventing future accidents.

The NTSB is authorized to "conduct hearings...administer oaths, and require, by subpoena or otherwise, necessary witnesses and evidence." 49 U.S.C. § 1113(a)(1). The NTSB also may "inspect any record, process, control, or facility related to an accident investigation...." 49 U.S.C. § 1134(a)(2) and (f).

If a subpoena, order, or inspection notice of the NTSB is disobeyed, the Board may obtain a court order for enforcement from the appropriate district court of the United States. 49 U.S.C. § 1113(a)(4).

The requested records are important to the NTSB's investigation into the above-referenced accident, and we appreciate your anticipated cooperation.
