Officer Narrative: ALLEN, DAVID

On 08/26/11 at approximately 1901 hours, I Deputy Allen [REDACTED] was dispatched to NE 144th Street and Cameron Road to check the area for a Life -Net medical helicopter that was having possible fuel problems.

While enroute I was advised by Dispatch that the resident at [REDACTED] had located a helicopter crash north of his residence. The caller further advised that he observed at least two casualties. Sgt. Wilhelm [REDACTED] Deputy Bennett [REDACTED] Deputy Foster [REDACTED] and Mosby Police Department responded to assist. Excelsior Springs Fire Department and Kearney Fire Department also responded to the scene.

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Upon my arrival I made contact with Mosby Police Officer Wade [REDACTED] who advised he found two victims who appeared to be already deceased. I observed a large crash scene scattered throughout the field. As I canvassed the crash scene for any survivors I located a third and fourth victim who appeared to be deceased. I advised Dispatch I had located the other two victims.

Deputy Foster [REDACTED] started a Crime Scene Log, and Deputy Bennett photographed the scene (see supplement reports). Kearney Fire Department responded and did not detect any signs of life for all four victims at the scene of the crash.

As I began to canvass the crash scene for information I located a Federal Air Administration card with the tail number N352LN. The helicopter was identified on the card as a Euro copter AS-350 B2.

I responded to [REDACTED] where I made contact with Mayes, Donald L. W/M [REDACTED] who advised the following:

- \* He did not hear or witness the crash.
- \* He stepped out of his residence around 1900 hours when he observed the wreckage and smoke in the field north of his residence.
- \* He called 911 to report the crash.
- \* He responded to the crash and immediately located two victims who appeared to be deceased.
- \* He advised Dispatch he would wait at the gate entrance to the field to direct responding units to the scene.

I then responded to the Midwest National Air Center located at 13106 Rhodus Road to make contact with the attendant who was working when the helicopter was enroute there for fuel.

I made contact with Hewitt, John L. [REDACTED] who advised the following:

- \* He received a call around 1830 hours from Life-Net Dispatch advising they had a medical

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helicopter enroute that would need to stop and refuel.

- \* They further advised the helicopter should arrive in approximately 19 minutes.
- \* He was contacted by the pilot of the Life-Net helicopter at around 1845 hours advising they were approximately five miles from the airport.
- \* He went to the refuel truck and stood by waiting for the helicopter to land.
- \* After several minutes he did not see the helicopter and became concerned.
- \* He decided to take his personal vehicle out to the runway and see if he could see the inbound helicopter.
- \* As he stepped out of the refuel truck he received a second call from Life- Net inquiring if the helicopter had landed.
- \* He told them no and they requested to have the pilot call Life-Net Dispatch as soon as they arrive.
- \* He then received a third call from Life-Net inquiring again if the helicopter had landed, that they had lost radio communication with the helicopter.
- \* He once again told them the helicopter still had not landed, but he would notify them as soon as it did.
- \* He then received a fourth call from Life-Net. This time it was a different caller inquiring if the helicopter had landed.
- \* He told them no and inquired if the helicopter was fuel critical and they advised it was.
- \* He immediately drove to the edge of the runway to see if he could see the helicopter or any sign of a crash.
- \* He did not see anything that would indicate there was a crash.
- \* He contacted another aircraft pilot that was in the area and inquired if he would check the area for a crashed helicopter.
- \* The pilot advised he had received an alert from an impact beacon indicating an aircraft had an impact close by.
- \* The pilot then radioed the crash site was somewhere near Rocky Hollow Park according to the strength of the beacon.
- \* The pilot then contacted him and stated he located the crash west of Cameron Road in a field.

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- \* The pilot stated there was no fire and a little smoke around the crash site.
- \* He identified the pilot of the aircraft that located the crash as Mr. Shannon Knee and he could be reached at [REDACTED]

I responded back to the crash scene and relayed all the information I received to Detective Norris [REDACTED]

I made several attempts to obtain victim identification from Life-Net and their parent company Air Methods with negative results. I was able to contact Mr. Mike Stacey with Air Methods who advised all the information except for the patient on board would be brought to the scene on 08/27/11 by upper management of Air Methods who was responding from Denver Colorado to observe the wreckage.

I was able to confirm from Mr. Stacey that all of the victim's, who were employed by Air Methods, families were notified of the crash.

I recorded the crash scene upon arrival with my Scorpion DVR. I copied the video to three DVD's placing one into evidence and attaching two to this report. I also copied the statements of Mr. Mayes and Mr. Hewitt onto three CD's placing one of each statement into evidence and attaching the others to this report.

Sgt. Copp [REDACTED], Sgt. Ruth [REDACTED], and Deputy O'Doherty [REDACTED] remained on the scene to secure the area until the National Transportation Safety Board could arrive and conduct their investigation.

This report will be forwarded to the Clay County Detective Unit for further investigation.

Officer Narrative: NORRIS, PAUL  
Lead: Initial Response to Scene

On 08/26/2011, at approximately 1940 hours, I, Detective P. Norris [REDACTED] received a phone call from Sergeant S. Wilhelm [REDACTED] regarding an aircraft that had crashed with four fatalities.

On the same date at approximately 2018 hours, I arrived at the scene of where the aircraft had gone down. I noted that the aircraft was a helicopter with red, blue and white markings.

I then contacted Sergeant S. Wilhelm who informed me that the helicopter in question was a Life-Net Medical transport helicopter and had four parties on board at the time of the crash. Sgt. S. Wilhelm further advised me that all four victims had been checked for signs of life three separate times with all three being negative. Sgt. S. Wilhelm also said that he observed what he believed were three crew members belonging to the helicopter service along with one patient.

After speaking with Sgt. S. Wilhelm, I entered the perimeter to conduct an initial survey of the scene. During my initial walk through of the scene I observed the following:

- \* I observed the remains of what use to be a fully intact helicopter along with a large debris field.
- \* Upon approaching the largest portion of the helicopter, I observed a victim which was still secured to a seat in an inverted position lying over the tail section.
- \* I then located and observed another victim which was still secured in a seat lying on their left side.
- \* I then located and observed two separate victims who were in close proximity of each other.
- \* One victim was laying face down and had what appeared to be straps from a backboard

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attached to them and the board.

\* The second victim was still secured in a seat and was lying on their left side.

I then exited the perimeter and again contacted Sgt. S. Wilhelm and inquired about contacting the Jackson County Medical Examiners Office to request an Investigator to respond. Sgt. S. Wilhelm advised me that the Medial Examiners Office had been contacted and were enroute.

At approximately 2051 hours Medical Investigator Shaun Hachinsky arrived on scene and began his investigation. I then contacted Jim Wesley of the Federal Air Administration who had arrived. Mr. Wesley and I entered the perimeter and he began his assessment of the scene. A short time later I was advised that the victims could be removed due to them being outside of the aircraft.

Members of the Kearney Fire Department along with me and Deputies of the Clay County Sheriff's Office assisted Medical Examiner Shaun Hachinsky with the recovery of the victims.

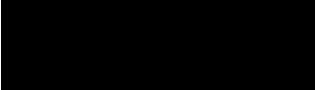

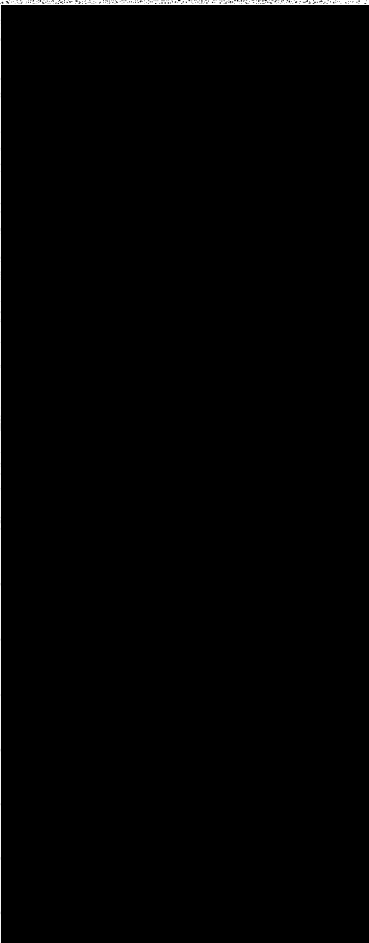
