## Description of CD contents:

- (1) AVI format digital video file, containing an excerpt from the recording that shows the bridge collapse. This file was exported from the viewing software provided by the DVR manufacturer. The AVI file is viewable using a PC and most of the recent versions of Microsoft Windows Media Player. Other playback viewers may be suitable as well. Note that the time displayed in this excerpt reflects the DVR's internal clock, which was found to be 3 minutes and 19 seconds behind the U.S. Naval Observatory clock, referred to in the Video Study Report.
- (1) annotated .WMV format digital video file, containing an excerpt from the recording taken on the morning of the accident, between 09:00 an 09:20 am (approximately) Central Daylight Time. The WMV file is viewable using a PC and most of the recent versions of Microsoft Windows Media Player. Other playback viewers may be suitable as well.
- (31) individual still images in JPEG format. These still images are the same as those provided in the Video Study Report in the section entitled **Complete Sequence of Recorded Video Images from 18:03:58 to 18:05:07 CDT.** These images were exported from the viewing software provided by the DVR manufacturer.
