As I have stated in the past, on our flight on November 28, 2004 both Teddy and I were wearing our scatbelts. Neither of us unbuckled our scatbelts at any time before the crash, and more specifically, Teddy did not get up out of his seat at any point.

Charlie was not wearing his seatbelt during take-off from Montrose. Any statements attributed to him to the contrary are in error.

Before we took off from Montrose, no one from the Hight crew came back into the cabin of the aircraft to look out of the window to observe the wing conditions. Additionally, at no time either from Van Nuys or from Montrose did the flight crew give...or offer to give...a safety briefing.

This document was produced at the last minute and I was able to track down my son. Charlie, who I interrupted, but was able to give me the opportunity to review this information with him and he is in full agreement with the above stated facts.
