Upon successful completion and documentation of having met these requirements, the completed Requirements & Training Plan For Conducting Efficiency Tests and Competency Checklist must be forwarded to the Assistant Division Superintendent for review and approval. Once qualification has been approved, Training Codes 9555, "Program of Operational Tests and Inspections" and 9651, "Conducting Efficiency Testing - Demonstrated Proficiency", is to be entered in the supervisor's training history. Copies of the completed Training Plan and Competency Checklist must be retained on the supervisor's Virtual Personnel File (VPF).
