2	MR. CHHATRE: On the record. Good evening, today is
3	Monday, January 3rd, 2011. We are currently in Burlingame,
4	California at the San Francisco Airport Marriott. We are meeting
5	in regards to investigation of pipeline rupture in San Bruno,
6	California that occurred on September 9, 2010. The NTSB accident
7	number for this investigation is DCA-10-MP-008.
8	My name is Ravi Chhatre and I'm with National
9	Transportation Safety Board, and I'm investigator-in-charge of
10	this accident.
11	I'd like to start by notifying everyone in this room
12	that we are recording this interview for transcription at a later
13	date. All parties will have a chance to review the transcripts
14	when they are completed. Also, I would like to inform well,
15	make sure I pronounce your name right. Is it Breiz?
16	MR. BREIZ: Jareau Breiz.
17	MR. CHHATRE: Breiz, okay. I'd like to inform Mr. Breiz
18	that you are permitted to have one other person present with you
19	during your interview. This is a person of your choice; it can be
20	a supervisor, friend, family member, attorney, or if you choose,
21	nobody at all.
22	Please state for the record your full name, spelling of
23	your name, contact information, such as e-mail address, telephone,

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1 MR. BREIZ: My is Jareau Breiz. I'm a PGE employee. My contact number is (650) 515----. My address is -----2 3 -----Pacifica, California ----. 17 INTERVIEW OF JAREAU BREIZ

18 BY MR. GUNTHER:

19 Q. Okay. Let me start out first, what is your title?

20 A. I'm a gas service representative.

21 Q. Okay. And how about your formal education?

A. Formal education, graduated 2000 Westmore High School,
Daly City, California. Some general education at Skyline College,
San Bruno.

25 Q. All right. I'll tell you what, can you start from the

day, the day of the accident from the time you went into work,
 what you did and just go ahead and give me a narrative, just tell
 me what happened.

A. I believe I started my work in San Bruno doing some
service calls. I don't remember what kind of service calls they
were, but I do remember getting an immediate response call of a
possible fire in San Bruno.

8 Q. And then what did you do?

9 A. That's where I got a call from our dispatch of a 10 possible call -- of a possible fire in San Bruno. I then 11 proceeded to go to the area of where the fire was supposed to be.

12 Q. And?

13 A. And --

14 Q. Just go ahead and keep --

15 A. Oh, okay.

16 Q. Yeah.

17 Then, once I got there, I had met with a fellow PG&E Α. 18 employee by the name of Scott Robinson (ph.), and I tried to get information from him of what was going on. He didn't know at the 19 20 time what was going on. I saw fire. I don't know how high it 21 was, but it was pretty high. I then contacted our dispatch, 22 informed them that there was a fire. Then after that, I hung up I called the supervisor in charge, Barry Stillwell 23 with him. 24 (ph.), let him know that I was on site and what -- I hadn't 25 noticed what was going on. After I spoke with Barry Stillwell, I

also contacted another supervisor, Wyman Coe (ph.), also let him 1 know that I was on site. He let me know that he was on his way. 2 Then I went on standby and waited for him to arrive. Once he 3 4 arrived, we waited for several hours before I went down to escort some coroners down to the site. After I had escorted the coroners 5 б down to the site, I reported back to Wyman Coe and proceeded to 7 standby till maybe about 3:00. At that time I was released. 8 And we're talking 3:00 a.m.? Ο. 9 Α. А.М. 10 The next morning. Ο. MR. GUNTHER: Okay, no more questions. 11 MR. CALDWELL: Geoff Caldwell. No questions at this 12 13 time. 14 MR. DAUBIN: No questions. 15 MR. FASSETT: Bob Fassett, PG&E. 16 BY MR. FASSETT: 17 Just to clarify, as a GSR or gas service representative, Q. 18 you were called as a first responder; is that correct? 19 Α. Correct. That was to provide information back to dispatch as to 20 Ο. 21 what was going on at the site; is that --2.2 Α. Yes. 23 Q. Thank you. 24 MS. JACKSON: No questions. 25 FABRY: No questions. MS.

1MR. SHORI:Sunil Shori with the California PUC.2BY MR. SHORI:

3 Q. Mr. Breiz, who contacted you, and what were you -- where 4 were you working exactly when you received the call?

A. I believe I was on the way to a job in Daly City. I believe I was in Daly City at that time I got the call from our dispatch. I think the dispatch name was Sean. I only know him by his first name. So, once I got the call from him saying that there was a possible fire, that's when I headed back towards San Bruno.

11 Q. And where in Daly City just generally, I mean location 12 wise?

A. I believe I was around Junipisara and Serramoni (ph.)Boulevard.

15 Q. Did it take you a while to get to the location in San 16 Bruno where you were directed?

17 A. Yes, it did.

18 Q. And why is that?

19 A. A lot of traffic. Traffic was being held up.

20 Q. And as a gas service representative, you're not 21 authorized to operate mainline valves; am I right?

22 A. No.

23 Q. Just confirming.

A. Yes, I'm not.

25 Q. Okay. I think that's it. Thank you.

1 MR.	KATCHMAR:	No	questions.
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2 MS. MAZZANTI: No questions.

3 MR. SPERRY: No questions.

4 BY MR. CHHATRE:

Q. A couple of follow-up questions. Ravindra Chhatre NTSB.
You said Sean from your dispatch call you.

7 A. Yes.

8 Q. Do you recall approximately what time?

9 A. I don't know exactly. No -- maybe after 6:00.

10 Q. Did he call you on your personal phone or company phone?

11 A. It was the company phone.

Q. And to Bob Fassett's question you responded that as a
gas service representative you are first responder to incidences?
A. Yes.

15 Q. And what kind of incidences you would typically respond 16 to?

17 A. Gas leaks, fire structures, unsafe appliances.

18 Q. When you say gas leaks, you're talking about the service 19 lines, main lines, or inside of homes?

20 A. Any type of gas leak.

Q. Any kind. Okay. Now, what you would have done if you were at the location in real life and you had to close a valve? I think you mentioned that you could not close any mainline valves? A. No, I cannot.

25 Q. And just for the record, I mean, I want this information

1 only for the record here. Dispatch, is there only one dispatch 2 outfit for PG&E? One location that everybody gets dispatch or do 3 we have multiple dispatch locations?

A. For our service department, I believe there is only one5 dispatch call center.

6 Q. And where is that?

7 A. I believe it's in Concord.

Q. Ok. Do you recall at what time you arrived at the9 ground zero location?

10 A. I don't recall the time.

11 Q. Were there other PG&E people when you arrived at the 12 scene?

A. There was a PG&E employee. I believe his name was ScottRobinson. He had just arrived there right before I did.

15 Q. And where did you meet Mr. Robinson?

A. I believe it was San Bruno Avenue. He had parked near the site. He had just parked and he was getting out, and I parked behind his truck.

19 Q. Okay. And how long you -- was that the incident command 20 location at that time?

A. I believe it ended up being the post where everybodyrallied at.

Q. Okay. And how long you stayed at that location until you escorted, I guess, coroner? How long you were there that location before you escorted somebody?

1 Oh, the coroners? I don't remember the time. It was Α. 2 late in the evening. Once the fires had gone down and they 3 cleared us to go through. 4 Ο. So all the fires were out when you escorted? 5 Α. Yes. 6 Ο. Okay. And that was done at the incident commander or 7 was it done at the PG&E, somebody from PG&E told you to do that? 8 My -- the leading supervisor, Wyman Coe, had asked me Α. 9 to. 10 Ο. I have no further questions. Thank you so much for your help on that day and our investigation. 11 You're welcome. 12 Α. 13 MR. NARVELL: No questions for Mr. Breiz. Thank you. 14 MR. CHHATRE: Any follow-up questions? 15 MR. NICHOLSON: I've got one. 16 BY MR. NICHOLSON: 17 Maybe you said this -- Matt Nicholson NTSB. What time Q. 18 did you start work? 19 I start work at 4. Α. 20 Ο. 4? 21 Α. P.M. 22 P.M. Okay. Thanks. Q. 23 MR. CHHATRE: Nobody has any questions? 24 Thank you again for your help in the investigation. 25 MR. BREIZ: You're welcome.
