- MR. CHHATRE: Good evening. Today is Wednesday, January
- 3 5th, 2011. We are currently in Burlingame, California, at the San
- 4 Francisco Airport Marriott.
- 5 MR. GARRIESERE: In Burlingame?
- 6 MR. CHHATRE: Yes, sir. We are meeting in regards to
- 7 the investigation of pipeline rupture.
- 8 MR. GARRIESERE: Yes.
- 9 MR. CHHATRE: That occurred on September 9, 2010.
- MR. GARRIESERE: Yes, I remember that.
- 11 MR. CHHATRE: The accident number for this investigation
- 12 is DCA-10-MB-008. My name is Ravi Chhatre and I'm with National
- 13 Transportation Safety Board in Washington, D.C.
- MR. GARRIESERE: Yes.
- 15 MR. CHHATRE: And I am Investigator-in-Charge of this
- 16 accident.
- I would like to start by notifying you, via phone, and
- 18 everybody in this room, that we are recording this interview for
- 19 transcription at a later date. Did you hear that?
- 20 MR. GARRIESERE: Yeah. Recording this interview, you
- 21 said.
- MR. CHHATRE: Yes, sir.
- MR. GARRIESERE: For a later date?
- 24 MR. CHHATRE: No, for writing down the notes for a later
- 25 date, transcription later date. All parties will have a chance to

- 1 review the transcripts when they are completed.
- 2 Also, Mr. Garriesere, I would like to inform you that
- 3 you are permitted to have one other person present with you during
- 4 the interview.

- 23 representative. Of course, he can change that, but that was
- 24 already represented.

- MR. GARRIESERE: Yes, please.
- MR. CHHATRE: Okay. Now, we'll go through the people
- 14 here. Everybody will tell who they are and with whom they work
- 15 for, so wait for five minutes until everybody is done. I guess
- 16 start with you.
- 17 MR. DAUBIN: Brian Daubin, PG&E. My information is on

- 20 BY MR. CHHATRE:
- 21 Q. Mr. Garriesere, can you tell us your background a little
- 22 bit, how long you worked for PG&E, from when to when?
- 23 A. Thirty-two years.
- 24 Q. Okay.
- 25 A. Retired.

- 1 Q. And do you recall, when did you start working for PG&E?
- 2 A. It's a long time ago. I don't have the faintest idea
- 3 when it was.
- 4 Q. That's fine. Do you remember when you retired from
- 5 PG&E?
- 6 A. I've been trying to find that record here in my files.
- 7 Q. That's okay. If you don't remember, that's okay.
- 8 A. When I retired.
- 9 Q. Okay. Do you remember what kind of work you did for
- 10 PG&E?
- 11 A. It was gas pipelines.
- 12 Q. Okay.
- 13 A. In subdivisions mostly.
- Q. Okay. When you say gas pipelines, what did you do for
- 15 the gas pipelines?
- 16 A. I was in charge of crews installing distribution mains
- 17 and gas services.
- 18 Q. Okay.
- 19 A. For homes. And then later after -- that was all in
- 20 general construction.
- 21 Q. Okay.
- 22 A. I was looking up to get a job in gas operations in San
- 23 Francisco.
- Q. Okay. And did you?
- 25 A. Senior gas engineer.

- 1 O. Did you work on this gas transmission line, the big
- 2 pipe, 30-inch, in Bay area, the one that ruptured?
- A. No, I was trying to search my memory. I have no
- 4 recollection of having been on it at all.
- 5 Q. Okay. On the distribution main, what is the largest
- 6 pipe? What is the largest pipe you worked on?
- 7 A. I'd say eight-inch pipeline.
- 8 Q. Eight-inch.
- 9 A. That's pretty large for distribution.
- 10 Q. Okay.
- 11 A. It was two-inch, three-inch and four-inch size.
- 12 Q. Okay. There's no work done by you that you recall on
- 13 the transmission lines?
- 14 A. Not on the one you spoke of.
- 15 Q. Okay. Anything else you want to tell us that might help
- 16 this investigation?
- 17 A. Transmission jobs.
- 18 Q. Okay. Do you have any information that you would like
- 19 us to consider during this investigation of this pipe that
- 20 ruptured in San Bruno?
- 21 A. No, I didn't.
- 22 MR. CHHATRE: Wonderful. We want to thank you for the
- 23 time you have stayed with us, and sometime in the future if you
- 24 recall something, feel free to give me a call.
- MR. GARRIESERE: Okay. Would you send me one of your

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business cards or something so that I could remember the name?
