- 16 DISPATCHER: Affirmative, TAC 35.
- 17 ENGINE 64: Copy. Can you relay a message to Command?
- 18 We have an active hydrant at Claremont and Concord. Also a
- 19 patient with severe third-degree burns at the 1500 block of
- 20 Claremont. We will require an ambulance at that location.
- 21 DISPATCHER: Engine 64, 10-4.
- 22 ENGINE 93: Command 31 to 93 for a staging area.
- DISPATCHER: As far I know, there is no staging. It's
- 24 directly to the scene.
- 25 Glenview IC advise.

- 1 ENGINE 91: Glenview IC, Engine 91 is on scene. Do you
- 2 have an assignment for us?
- 3 GLENVIEW IC: Command 31, Glenview IC.
- 4 DISPATCHER: Glenview IC, go ahead.
- 5 GLENVIEW IC: Can you see if CAL FIRE is available to
- 6 get a fly over this thing so we can see what we have? We have no
- 7 idea. If they can get us some reconnaissance from above?
- 8 DISPATCHER: Glenview IC, 10-4. Are you clear to copy
- 9 some additional information?
- 10 GLENVIEW IC: Can you repeat?
- 11 DISPATCHER: We have one engine reporting there is a
- 12 active hydrant at Claremont and Concord, active hydrant at
- 13 Claremont and Concord, and we have a third-degree patient at 1500
- 14 Claremont that's going to need medical attention.

- 23 ENGINE 91: Glenview IC, Engine 91 is on scene. Do you
- 24 have an assignment for us?
- 25 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: (Indiscernible) 10 minutes out on

- 1 your water (indiscernible).
- 2 ENGINE 33: Engine 33 on Command 31, what's the ETA for
- 3 water?
- 4 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: We're looking at 10 minutes.
- 5 ENGINE 34: Glenview IC from Engine 34. Where do you
- 6 want us?
- 7 ENGINE 51: Crestmoor IC from Engine 51. We're going to
- 8 disconnect hose lines and back up to a safer position until we get
- 9 water.
- 10 CRESTMOOR IC: That's affirmative. Still, I want you to

- 17 Standby 1, for a staging area.
- 18 DISPATCHER: Unit that has -- communications for IC, go
- 19 ahead.
- 20 CLAREMONT IC: Claremont IC.
- 21 DISPATCHER: Claremont IC.
- 22 CLAREMONT IC: Correct. And Glenview IC, could you make
- 23 staging? Staging area is going to be Leonardi's parking lot on
- 24 San Bruno Avenue.
- DISPATCHER: I copy staging is going to be at Leonardi's

- 1 parking lot on San Bruno.
- 2 CLAREMONT IC: That's affirmative.
- 3 DISPATCHER: 10-4.
- 4 ENGINE 72: Engine 72 is on scene. You got an
- 5 assignment?
- 6 ENGINE 34: IC from Engine 34 on scene. Where do you
- 7 want us?
- 8 GLENVIEW IC: 34, standby. I might be sending you to
- 9 North Branch.
- 10 ENGINE 34: Copy that.
- 11 GLENVIEW IC: North Branch from Glenview IC.

- GLENVIEW IC: 34, copy. We need a lot of foam. We got

- 24 Water is going to be a problem. We have airport coming in. So
- 25 just advise on your resource needs. We have staging on San Bruno

- 1 Avenue.
- NORTH BRANCH: Copy that. If we can get a water tender
- 3 into the 1800 block of Claremont, that will save us.
- 4 GLENVIEW IC: Copy that. We'll order a water tender.
- 5 Command 31, Glenview IC.
- 6 DISPATCHER: Glenview IC, go ahead.
- 7 GLENVIEW IC: Can you start two water tenders to our
- 8 location?
- 9 DISPATCHER: Copy, two water tenders at 1800 Claremont.
- 10 GLENVIEW IC: Go ahead, IC.
- 11 CHIEF GREEN: Get ready for water down there. We have
- 12 one hydrant, and I'll get you another one in a few.

- 5 ENGINE 93: (Indiscernible) Engine 93. Suggestion, we
- 6 could do some tandem pumping, get water to those areas down there
- 7 to you.
- 8 TRUCK 51: IC, Truck 51. Supposedly I've got -- the
- 9 airport is not missing an airplane at this point.

- 6 tenders: Water Tender 8, 56 and 57 en route.
- 7 COMMUNICATIONS: 10-4.
- 8 CHIEF HAYES: Communications, Chief Hayes.
- 9 BATTALION 6: Glenview IC, this is Battalion 6 on scene.
- 10 ENGINE 33: Battalion 9 from 33.
- 11 ENGINE 34: Truck 34 on scene stage.
- 12 ENGINE 72: Glenview IC. Be advised Engine 72 has a
- 13 medical aid at staging, a citizen, chest pain.
- 14 ENGINE 63: IC from 63 on 31.
- 15 ENGINE 35: West Branch, Engine 35. West Branch from
- 16 Engine 35.
- 17 ENGINE 63: IC, Engine 63. We've got a hydrant at
- 18 (discernible).
- 19 BATTALION 6: IC, this is Battalion 6 on scene. Any
- 20 orders?
- 21 DISPATCHER: Communications, Com 31.
- 22 COMMUNICATIONS: Go ahead.
- 23 DISPATCHER: Information, we have two strike teams from
- 24 Alameda County, type 1's. They're staging at Tanforan.
- Battalion 18, North Branch IC, Command 31.

- 1 BATTALION 18: This is North Branch. Go ahead.
- 2 DISPATCHER: Be advised I have a bunch of medical calls.
- 3 Confirm you're handling medical?
- 4 BATTALION 18: Command 31, say again to North Branch.
- 5 DISPATCHER: North Branch, confirm you're handling
- 6 medicals? I have a couple medical calls pending.
- 7 BATTALION 18: We can handle the medical. We've got the
- 8 resources. I don't know if we'll have access to get to that
- 9 location. Go ahead and give me the addresses.
- 10 DISPATCHER: For one call I already have AMR on scene,
- 11 so I'm not going to send a fire response for Glen and Plymouth.

- 20 if we've got people in staging, I want (indiscernble) away from
- 21 the IC. So let's go ahead and move a couple engines from staging
- 22 to respond to those medicals.
- 23 ENGINE 28: Command 31, 28 in staging.
- 24 DISPATCHER: 28, 10-4.
- 25 Communications, Command 31.

- 1 COMMUNICATIONS: Go ahead.
- 2 DISPATCHER: Be advised we have one San Francisco Strike
- 3 Team en route also to stage at Tanforan.
- 4 COMMUNICATIONS: Okay. 10-4.
- 5 BATTALION 18: Command 31, North Branch.
- 6 DISPATCHER: North Branch, go ahead.
- 7 BATTALION 18: Let's see if we can have the two hose
- 8 tenders from North County respond from Engine 91 and 93. We may
- 9 need them to either shuttle water or set up an extended leg.
- 10 DISPATCHER: You need two of the water tenders to go to
- 11 91 and 93?
- 12 BATTALION 18: No, there's a house at 91 and 93. We've
- 13 got -- we have hose tenders there.
- 14 CHIEF 20A: North Branch, this is Chief 20A on 31.
- 15 COMMUNICATIONS: Command 31, Communications.
- 16 DISPATCHER: Communications, go ahead.
- 17 COMMUNICATIONS: We're going to go to area command.
- 18 Direct all communications through the com unit. All branches
- 19 place your resource request through the area commander on
- 20 Command 31. Area command in effect.
- 21 DISPATCHER: Area command in effect. All branches make
- 22 requests through area command or Command 31.
- 23 COMMUNICATIONS: Staging, Communications.
- Staging, area Communications, Command 31.
- 25 Command 31, area Communications.

- 1 DISPATCHER: Area Communications.
- 2 COMMUNICATIONS: One more TAC channel for medical group,
- 3 please.
- 4 BATTALION 5: Glenview IC from Battalion 5 on
- 5 Command 31.
- 6 DISPATCHER: The Command will use TAC 36 for medical,
- 7 TAC 36.
- 8 COMMUNICATIONS: Copy that.
- 9 AREA COMMAND: Command 31, if you get any resource
- 10 requests direct and I miss it, just have them go back through me.
- 11 DISPATCHER: Area Command, 10-4.
- 12 COMMUNICATIONS: Staging, Area Communications,
- 13 Command 31. Anybody in staging answer up. I need to make a
- 14 staging manager.
- 15 ENGINE 81: Engine 81.
- 16 COMMUNICATIONS: Anybody in staging answer up. I need a
- 17 staging manager.
- 18 Attention all units on the fire ground. We're in area
- 19 command. Repeat, we're in area command. All units switch to the
- 20 TAC channel. TAC 26 is in use for the medical group. All
- 21 resource ordering go through the area commander.
- 22 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: George, it's a blind line on
- 23 Glenview.
- 24 BATTALION 5: Engine 91 from Battalion 5. Are you on
- 25 TAC 35?

- 1 ENGINE 91: Currently on 31.
- 2 CHIEF HAYES: Engine 81, Chief Hayes.
- 3 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Engine area command
- 4 (indiscernible).
- 5 BATTALION 5: Engine 91 from Battalion 5 on TAC 35.
- 6 BATTALION 18: North Branch Area Communications,
- 7 Command 31. North Branch Area Communications, Command 31.
- 8 AREA COMMUNICATIONS: Area Communications on Com 32.
- 9 BATTALION 18: Go ahead.
- 10 AREA COMMUNICATIONS: I'm on Skyline stuck in my POV.
- 11 I'm coming up to West San Bruno Avenue. Should I make the turn?
- 12 BATTALION 18: Yeah, affirmative. San Bruno Avenue
- 13 East, make your first left. We're just north of the parking lot.
- 14 AREA COMMUNICATIONS: Copy.
- 15 DISPATCHER: Area Command, Command 31.
- 16 AREA COMMUNICATIONS: Command 31, you call Area Com?
- 17 DISPATCHER: Affirmative. Confirming that the staging
- 18 is Leonardi's parking lot still.
- 19 AREA COMMUNICATIONS: That's affirmative.
- DISPATCHER: 10-4.
- 21 COMMAND 31: North Branch Area Communications,
- 22 Command 31.
- 23 BATTALION 18: This is North Branch. Go.
- 24 COMMAND 31: North Branch, do you have access location
- 25 for the crash truck to make it to the scene?

- BATTALION 18: Say again. All I heard was crash truck.

- 4 AREA COM: Command 31, Area Com.
- 5 DISPATCHER: Area Com.
- 6 AREA COM: When you can, I'll need a representative from
- 7 San Bruno Water at the command post.
- 8 DISPATCHER: 10-4. We had them dispatched earlier.
- 9 I'll send them to the command post.
- 10 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Go ahead. Go ahead, Battalion 5.
- 11 COMMUNICATIONS: Area Communications on Command 31.
- DISPATCHER: Area Com, go ahead. Area Command, were you
- 13 calling Command 31?
- 14 AREA COM: Engine 92, Engine 92, Area Com on 31. Any
- 15 unit in staging answer up to Area Communications.

- 1 update. We are at a school on Crestview, and currently there's a
- 2 grove of eucalyptus. The fire is heading towards us. If it gets
- 3 into the eucalyptus, we got problems over here.

- 5 BATTALION 6: That's correct. East Branch.
- 6 GLENVIEW IC: How many resource and what type do you

- 19 BATTALION 18: Chief 20A, go ahead. Area Com.
- 20 CHIEF 20A: Yeah, I'm probably 5 to 10 minutes out. Do
- 21 you have a location you'd like me to report to?
- 22 BATTALION 18: Just come to the command post for now,
- 23 Glenview and San Bruno Avenue.
- 24 CHIEF 20A: Glenview and San Bruno, copy. Thank you.
- 25 BATTALION 18: North Branch Area Communications,

- 1 Command 31. Attention all branches. Attention all branches.
- 2 Standby for PA (ph.) for the IC. All units stand by for a PA on
- 3 command.
- 4 WEST BRANCH: Staging Area Communications on command.
- 5 DISPATCHER: Area Command, Command 31.
- 6 WEST BRANCH: This is West Branch. (Indiscernible).
- 7 ENGINE 93: Engine 93, Engine 91.
- 8 ENGINE 91: Engine 91 to Engine 93, go.
- 9 ENGINE 93: Engine 93. We're over here on Earl. Just
- 10 come back to the firehouse. That's where we're at. We're
- 11 thinking of staying here on Earl.
- 12 DISPATCHER: Possible medical --
- 13 ENGINE 93: -- water settle.
- 14 AREA COM: Engine 95, Area Communications on command 31.
- 15 Engine 95, staging, Area Com, Command 31.
- DISPATCHER: Area Command, Com 31.
- 17 AREA COM: Command 31, go ahead, Area Com.
- 18 DISPATCHER: Area Com, we have two locations for public
- 19 assist with elderly Xs that need help evacuating, if you're clear
- 20 to copy addresses.
- 21 AREA COM: Go ahead.
- 22 DISPATCHER: The first one will be 1660, 1-6-6-0
- 23 Claremont Drive, San Bruno. Elderly X needs assistance. We have
- 24 two elderly females at 1651, 1-6-5-1 Claremont, off of Fairmont.
- 25 AREA COM: So 1660, 1-6-6-0, for one elderly X and 1-6-

- 1 5-1 for two?
- 2 DISPATCHER: That's affirmative.
- 3 AREA COM: Copy. (Indiscernible), Area Communications
- 4 on command. This is Com 32, Communications. 52 to North Branch,
- 5 Com 31.
- 6 DISPATCHER: Area Com, Command 31, another public
- 7 assist.
- 8 AREA COM: This is East Branch. Go ahead.
- 9 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Command 31, go ahead.
- 10 DISPATCHER: Command 31, it will be 1780 Earl Avenue
- 11 1-7-8-0, Earl Avenue, cross of Glenview and Daley Court.
- 12 Residents have evacuated. However, they're reporting two large
- 13 liquid O_2 tanks in the residence.
- 14 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Copy. North Branch Area
- 15 Communications, Command 31. North Branch Area Communications,
- 16 Command.
- 17 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Communications (indiscernible).
- 18 EAST BRANCH: Area Communications from East Branch on
- 19 Command 31.
- 20 ENGINE 34: IC confirm Engine 34.
- 21 EAST BRANCH: East Branch Communications.
- BATTALION 18: North Branch Com, go.
- 23 EAST BRANCH: North Branch. North Branch Area
- 24 Communications.
- 25 BATTALION 18: This is North Branch on 31. Go.

- 1 EAST BRANCH: North Branch I need a PAR, please.
- 2 AREA COM: Area Com to North Branch. Our PAR is on
- 3 Northwest, Battalion 18, 17 and 8, Engine 86, Engine 94, Engine
- 4 71, Engine 63, Med 62, Truck 95 and Quint 62.
- 5 BATTALION 18: Okay, North Branch, you're partly broken,
- 6 you're partly broken. Confirm Engine 86, Engine 94, Engine 71,
- 7 Engine -- Engine 63, Engine 62, Truck 95 and Quint 62?
- 8 AREA COM: That's affirm, only it's Med 62 from South
- 9 San Francisco or possibly Med 61, and it's Engine 86.
- BATTALION 18: Okay. Engine 86, Engine 94, Engine 71,
- 11 Engine 63, Rescue 61, Truck 95 and Quint 62?
- 12 AREA COM: That's affirmative and Battalion 8, 17 and
- 13 18.
- 14 BATTALION 18: North Branch 10-4.
- 15 EAST BRANCH: Area Command from East Branch on
- 16 Command 31.
- 17 ENGINE 34: IC with engine -- from Engine 34.
- 18 DISPATCHER: Area Command, Command 31.
- 19 BATTALION 18: North Branch, go.
- 20 AREA COM: Command 31, Area Com.
- 21 DISPATCHER: I have another public assist, and can you
- 22 advise foam truck from the airport is on scene?
- 23 AREA COM: Yeah, I copy. The crash truck is on scene
- 24 and go ahead.
- DISPATCHER: It's going to be subject stuck in an

- 1 elevator, 1000 National Avenue, 1000 National, San Bruno, cross is
- 2 Sneath and Commodore.
- 3 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: 10-4, can I have all the TACs in

- 19 AREA COM: East Branch, 10-4.
- 20 Staging manager, Area Com, Command 31.
- 21 DISPATCHER: Area Com, Command 31.
- 22 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Staging manager (indiscernible).
- 23 AREA COM: Area -- correction, staging manager Area
- 24 Communications, Command 31.
- 25 BATTALION 20: (Indiscernible) staging manager,

- 1 Battalion 20, over.
- 2 AREA COM: (Indiscernible), I need two engines to report
- 3 to East Branch. Battalion 6 is the branch at Crestmoor and
- 4 Lexington.
- 5 DISPATCHER: Area Command, Command 31.
- 6 AREA COM: Going to Area Com.
- 7 DISPATCHER: Area Com, Com 80 is also en route to
- 8 Glenview and San Bruno, and confirm do we need to send a separate
- 9 engine on that National Avenue for the elevator?
- 10 AREA COM: Negative at this point. We'll take care of
- 11 it from here unless I advise.
- 12 DISPATCHER: Area Com, 10-4.
- 13 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: IC to North Branch on 31.
- 14 DISPATCHER: Area Com, Command 31.
- 15 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: What?
- DISPATCHER: Be advised PG&E has turned the power off in
- 17 the area. Power is off.
- 18 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Copy that.
- 19 WATER TENDER 56: Crestmoor IC, Water Tender 56 at
- 20 intersection of Skyline and San Bruno Avenue. What are your
- 21 wishes?
- 22 DISPATCHER: Area Com, Water Tender 56 is asking for an
- 23 assignment.
- 24 CHIEF 11B: IC from Chief 11B.
- AREA COM: 11B, we have two engines and pump responding

- 1 to that location, Engine 72 and Engine 17.
- 2 CHIEF 11B: Staging Communications on command.
- 3 AREA COM: Yeah, this is staging.
- 4 CHIEF 11B: Staging, which apparatus do you have in
- 5 staging now?
- 6 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: IC staging, what resources do you
- 7 have?
- 8 QUINT 62: Command 31, Command 31 from Quint 62.
- 9 AREA COM: Quint 62, go to North Branch.
- 10 OUINT 62: North Branch?
- 11 AREA COM: Quint 62, be advised San Bruno PD has reports
- 12 of occupants trapped in 1651 Claremont. Copy 64 -- 1-6-5-1
- 13 Claremont.
- 14 QUINT 62: Copy, 1651 Claremont.
- 15 AREA COM: Staging Communications. Staging manager
- 16 Communications on command. Okay, Mark, when you get a second I
- 17 need to know what resources we have available.
- 18 Okay. Two engines to the East Branch for Battalion 6.
- 19 DISPATCHER: Area Com, Command 31.
- 20 AREA COM: Go ahead.
- 21 DISPATCHER: Water Tender 56 is asking for an
- 22 assignment.
- 23 AREA COM: Staging, please.
- 24 ENGINE 72: Crestmoor IC, Engine 72.
- 25 AREA COM: Staging, 10-4, East Branch Area

- 1 Communications. East Branch Area Communications on command.
- DISPATCHER: Area Com, Command 31.
- 3 AREA COM: Go ahead.
- 4 DISPATCHER: Do you want portable repeater deployed?
- 5 AREA COM: Say again?
- 6 DISPATCHER: Do you want the portable repeater deployed?
- 7 AREA COM: Yeah, let's go ahead and start that.
- 8 DISPATCHER: Area Com, Command 31.
- 9 AREA COM: Standby, please. IC to North Branch on
- 10 Command 31. Area Command to North Branch on 31. Is this Area
- 11 Command? Command 31, Area Communications.
- 12 DISPATCHER: Area Communications, go ahead.
- 13 AREA COM: Let's go one more alarm level in county.
- 14 Have everybody stage at the predesigned staging area.
- 15 DISPATCHER: And confirming that's Leonardi's still, or
- 16 is that Glenview and San Bruno?
- 17 AREA COM: Let's make it Leonardi's.
- 18 DISPATCHER: 10-4, and your portable repeater is a
- 19 one-hour ETA.
- 20 AREA COM: Copy that.
- 21 BATTALION 18: Command 31, North Branch.
- 22 COMMAND 31: Go ahead, North Branch.
- BATTALION 18: Yeah, Command 31, if possible I'd like to
- 24 get two water tenders or get a status on them, and we could use

- 19 We're sizing up the hill. If it starts to make a run in the
- 20 canyon we're out of here.
- 21 AREA COM: Okay. East Branch, keep me advised on your
- 22 situation.
- 23 EAST BRANCH: Copy that. We got a good eye on it now.
- 24 It's got to make it all the way down into the ravine before it
- 25 starts up the other side.

- 1 AREA COM: Copy that.
- DISPATCHER: Area Com, Command 31.
- 3 BATTALION 18: Area Command, Northwest.
- 4 AREA COM: Northwest go to Area Com.
- 5 BATTALION 18: Can we have an additional TAC channel, 36
- 6 or 37, for North Branch?
- 7 AREA COM: Affirmative, 3-7, 37.
- 8 BATTALION 18: Copy 37. Thank you.
- 9 DISPATCHER: Area Com, Command 31.
- 10 AREA COM: Go ahead.
- 11 DISPATCHER: With a six-alarm fire and the units already
- 12 on scene, it was just one additional engine, Engine 24.
- 13 EAST BRANCH: Area Command, East Branch, Command 31.
- 14 AREA COM: East Branch, go ahead to Area Com.
- 15 EAST BRANCH: I have two engines with me, Engine 72,
- 16 Engine 17, Battalion 6. We're all PAR.
- 17 AREA COM: East Branch, 10-4.
- 18 Command 31, Area Com.
- 19 DISPATCHER: Area Com, go ahead.
- 20 AREA COM: I'm going to need a fuel tender for this
- 21 location. I believe the closest is going to be out of San
- 22 Francisco, city of. You might want to check with Region 2 to make
- 23 a request.
- 24 DISPATCHER: Confirm you need additional water tenders
- with 8, 56, 57 and 58 already responding?

- 1 AREA COM: Negative. That will be a fuel tender. Fuel
- 2 tender.
