SSOA Requirements Under Part 659

- Establish a State Program Standard
- Ensure that a rail transit agency's System Safety Program Plan (SSPP) and System Safety Plan (SSP) conforms to that standard
- Review the SSPP and SSP at least once every three years
- Investigate hazardous conditions and accidents at rail transit systems and establish corrective action plans



FTA & SSOAs

- Conduct a safety review of the SSOA at least once every three years
- Receive and review the SSOA's Annual Report detailing its oversight activities during the past year
- Partner with the SSOA to investigate hazardous conditions and accidents at rail transit systems and establish corrective action plans
- Withhold up to 5% of a state's urbanized area funds if an SSOA is not in compliance



SSOA Requirements Under MAP-21

- Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21) requirements for SSOAs
 - Independent Financing
 - Independent Investigation Authority
 - Independent Enforcement Authority
- Only States with rail transit systems are subject to the MAP-21 requirements for State Safety Oversight
- 28 of 30 States in good standing to complete grant applications
 - Includes TOC



State Safety Oversight Grant Program

- State Safety Oversight Grant Program
 - \$58 Million in State Safety Oversight formula program funds to date
 - States must meet MAP-21 certification requirements or have an approved Certified Work Plan to become eligible for this grant funding
 - 17 States have been awarded SSO grants
 - TOC has not received funds...coordinating with FTA Region III
