## **Law Enforcement Curriculum for the Rail Safety Course**

### **Objectives**

To provide the law enforcement officer with the basic knowledge needed to safely enter the Metro roadway while in the performance of their duties. The officer could be in the pursuit of a subject or responding to a critical incident. The training will provide the law enforcement officer with hands on experience of how to survive, in unfamiliar surroundings.

The first part of the training course will offer classroom material and lecture on the workings of the Metro rail environment.

The second part of the course will provide an actual Metro station visit.

### **Goals**

To provide a basic level of safety for all law enforcement officers whose duties may require them to work in to Metro rail environment.

The Office of Emergency Management will provide the training and keep all attendance rosters and update the training as needed.
