Presumed accident: N13073 contacted Springs RADAR 9.5 miles NE of PSP at 6000' requesting flight following to PSP (16:21:22). CPC issued beacon code of 0205 which pilot acknowledged (16:22:20). There was no RADAR identification or further radio contact with N13073. NOP data displayed an aircraft in that vicinity beginning at 16:19:29 preceding southbound, target disappeared at 16:21:57.
