Actions on May 5th 2016

Upon arrival to the crash site, a victim was pointed in my direction to receive medical treatment. I walked him away from the crash site and the large fuel tanks, to a curb and had him sit down. While assessing his condition, I asked him if he remembered what happened. He stated that after takeoff, their plane had lost it's "left" engine, the other pilot told him that he would take the controls and was trying to "feather it" back in. Lt. Dudley Schrader retrieved a medical bag from one of the in coming units and came to my location. Again the

patient told us the same story as we were treating his burns and checking for further injury. MEMS arrived and took over patient care. We assisted in packaging and loading of the patient. No further contact was made.

Dear Sir,

The following events and/or statements occurred on Thursday, May 5, 2016 at the North Little Rock airport following a plane crash. Upon arrival of the crash site, Lieutenant Poole was walking a victim away from the plane crash and had the victim sit down. I noticed that the victim had obvious traumatic injuries, so I retrieved a medical bag from one of the responding engines that was already on site. Upon contact with the victim, I began medical treatment. During the course of providing medical treatment, Lt. Poole asked the victim "What had happened?". The victim stated "I was doing a check ride with the other pilot. We lost engine power. The other pilot took over and was trying to get it back." The victim also stated "I tried but could not pull the other pilot from the wreckage".

I responded on special ops 1 from the training tower to the plane crash. We were the first NLRFD unit on scene. Captain Stephens took command and I was assigned triage. There was a plane in a field on fire and fire around a diesel tank. As I made my way to the crash site I was met at the chain link fence by a pt. he had facial trauma and burns on his face and arms. I advised the pt. to continue walking to Lt. Poole. The pt. advised me that his buddy was still in the plane and he was unable to get him out. At this time T-1 arrived on scene and I felt they would be better suited to continue on to the crash site since I had no PPE. I met with Capt. Shoemaker and advised him that one pt. was with Lt. Poole and there was still someone in the plane. I then began pumping truck one and that's where I remained until I was relieved.
