About 5:00PM on Saturday, September 29, 2012, I was flying CFI-A right seat in N3069Y, the flight school's PA-28RT 201 with student Chris Scott, inbound from Stafford Airport to Shannon.

After a go-around at Shannon, Runway 6, we turned left-downwind and the student announced an position on unicom. I noticed a Cessna, later determined to be a C-150, ~~to~~ running up at the corner of the ramp for 24. After an call, he turned and announced his back taxi for runway 6.

When we turns base, I noticed the C150 ready to depart 6 and upon turning final, noticed the he was on take-off role about  $\frac{1}{3}$  <sup>rd</sup> of the way down the runway. We lost sight of him after he cleared the departure end. of Runway 6.

At about  $\frac{1}{2}$  -  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile final, I noted the plane ~~was~~ ~~had~~ banking as if in a 90° bank and turning left about 75-100 feet above the trees over the wetland ~~and~~ on departure. The plane continued to turn notes left to a nose down position, then disappeared behind the John Deere store. We landed, called 911, then called the airport manager.
