## **NARRATIVE**

On July 9, 2009, at approximately 1800 Zulu (1400 EST) I received a call from FWC dispatch in reference to a report of a downed aircraft in the vicinity of the Lake City Airport (LCQ). The report originated from the state EOC in Tallahassee. I was later given an approximate lat/long as to the reported position of the ELT. The lat/long showed the location to be in southern Baker County. I departed LCQ at 1915 Zulu, flying a State of Florida Bell 206 L4 (N402FW) and initiated a search for the missing aircraft. At approximately 2000 Zulu, and in an area 1.2 miles NE of the original lat/long, I located the crashed remains of a fixed wing aircraft. The position of the wreckage was N 30 10.53 W 82 19.30. It rested near the eastern edge of a cleared field and approximately 400 yards east of a hunt camp. I reported the position to our officers and to FWC dispatch. I landed near the crash site and approached on foot to access the possibility of any survivors. I was able to confirm one fatality in the wreckage. At 2030 Zulu, Fish and Wildlife Commission officers arrived and secured the site. I departed and returned to LCQ.
