On 6/11/2019 at 6:17pm a Cessna 182 Skylane pumped/received 21.1 gallons from our Avgas self-service pump. The morning of 6/12/2019 the aircraft departed KCEU in route to KORL. From our understanding, which is not confirmed, the aircraft landed at KORL and remained on the ground approximately an hour. No confirmation of refueling at KORL has been received. The aircraft departed KORL and shortly after take-off contacted ATC and reported a problem. We were told the aircraft crashed in a small lake and emergency personnel was notified.
