On August 5, 2016, at 11:30 EST, NTSB investigators Ensar Becic and Deborah Bruce interviewed the family of the interview was arranged by the family's attorney and was conducted by phone.
The investigators asked the family to provide some information about background. (father) and (father) provided the following
 attended University of Mexico, and had ROTC scholarship. After leaving the university, joined the Navy He spent 11 years in the Navy He was attached to explosives unit; one of his responsibilities included defusing bombs He was deployed to middle east and attached to Navy special warfare WMD university (weapons of mass destruction unit) Jeft the Navy in 2009 After leaving the Navy, worked at an electric technician for the next two years In 2011, started his own company—NEXU Innovation The company specialized in brining internet to rural areas
The investigators asked the family to provide some information about use and knowledge of his Tesla. His father was the most familiar about this topic and provided the following information:
 bought the vehicle new in 2015 The Tesla had 47, 680 miles on it at the time of the crash drove the vehicle a lot for this work; traveling to rural areas He loved the vehicle, was very interested in the technology was very knowledgeable about the Tesla

- did not make any modifications to the vehicle, as far as

was aware

The investigators asked the family about whereabouts in the days prior to the crash. The family reported that they all were in Disney Resorts, Orlando, Florida for a week before the crash. The family provided the following information:

- The family went to Disney Resorts in Orlando, FL.
 - o It was a late Christmas gif
 - o and arrived to Disney on May 1st
- arrived in the afternoon of May 1st
- The entire family, along with stayed at Disney until May 7th
- family arrived to Disney in their motor home.
- arrived in his Tesla
- The entire family spent the vacation in the motor home

The investigators asked the family about this general state of mind, level of stress in his life, health issues. The family provided the following information:

- was in good health, he did not have a primary physician, and did not take any medications
- was a runner, he biked, and did not drink or smoke
- There was no drama in the family
 - o grandmother died at 85, the year before the crash
- The family believed that was not stressed in his life
- was single, was never married, and did not have children
- stated that she helped with his company and that was excited about growing business prospects

The investigators asked the family about sleep pattern during the vacation and any contract that they had with him on the day of the crash. The family provided the following information:

- slept well during the vacation
- The vacation was relaxing, and seems quite relaxed throughout.
- On May 5th, attended a trade show, in the area.
- left Disney at 9:30 am on May 7th
 - He said good bye to family and drove to Cedar Key, Florida where we had an internet installation job.
 - texted his sister when he completed the job in Cedar Key and informed her that he was heading to Swamp Fox, North Carolina for his next job.
- The family stated that they speculate that was driving through Williston after finishing the work at Cedar Key because he was heading to Ocala to charge his Tesla.
