## **B.** Additional Injury Information

Following the publication of the initial injury matrix (Attachment A to the Injury Factual Report), additional information was received by the NTSB from a variety of sources. Table 1, below, describes the additional injury information including a narrative description and the corresponding NTSB injury level for these occupants of the train. AIS coding was not performed.

One of the injured who supplied information for this addendum was not previously identified as transported by the NTSB. As a result the total numbers of transports have been updated in Table 2.
