On July 19, 2011, the aircraft was inspected as requested by NuVenture aircraft recovery on site at the Dallas storage facility. The following damage was noted:

Spinner severely flattened, one propeller blade bent

Motor mount and boot cowl damage

Crankshaft appears bent

Inspected air intake, no obstructions

Alternate air functions normally

Throttle arm 1/8" from forward stop when in full forward position Mixture knob forward, mixture arm 3/8" from forward stop on fuel injector Secondary B-nut found on fuel pressure line, does not appear to have caused any problems

Engine had 6 ½ qts engine oil

Reconnected battery, boost pump operation normal but cavitating from no fuel Fuel sump drained, only 3 Tbsp fuel

No fuel out of main fuel line to fuel injector when boost pump turned on Unable to determine condition of fuel injector and flow divider without adding fuel to the fuel system.

Engine pulled through, all cylinders appear normal
