Was in his cabin at his time, asleep. Explosion occurred and he woke up, this was about 0645. Looked out the porthole and saw police vehicles. He then heard Code Alpha, and thereafter, Code Bravo.

He put on his slippers, went out the cabin door, made a right turn, and walked down the passageway. He looked down the passageway and saw people further down the passageway. He proceeded down the passageway, and upon passing the gangway saw his friends. In addition, he saw security personnel, shore side security, waving people ashore. He then went down the gangway to the shore. About 15 minutes later he heard the emergency signal.

He was asked to describe the emergency signal, and he initially could not remember the signal, but was able to describe it shortly thereafter.
