- 11 THE COURT: And is it the signature of your client?
- MS. KALFUS: Yes, it is.
- 13 THE COURT: All right. Does this settlement agreement
- 14 dispose of all issues in this case, Mr. Horowitz?
- 15 MR. HOROWITZ: Yes, it does, Your Honor.
- 16 THE COURT: Mr. Long?
- MR. LONG: Yes, it does, Your Honor.
- 18 THE COURT: Ms. Kalfus?
- MS. KALFUS: Yes, Your Honor.
- 20 THE COURT: Are there any side agreements, which are
- 21 unwritten affecting this case?
- MR. HOROWITZ: There are no side agreements, Your
- 23 Honor.
- 24 THE COURT: Mr. Long?
