ROMMEL DEANO-Crew 095, Galley utility, garbage disposal, 6 months into a 10-month contract, his 2<sup>nd</sup> contract on the Norway. Had previously worked for Carnival, about three contracts with them. His emergency assignment was water tight door, No. 24.

Typically worked around the Great Outdoors, Generally worked 0500 to 1700. At 0645 was on the international deck when he felt the aft portion of the ship rise vertically, and then he described a side to side motion. He did not describe hearing anything unusual. He went outside to see what was happening. He saw smoke and did notice the lights go out, and the emergency lights go on.

He proceeded to his cabin (1151, Caribbean deck). From the international deck to Caribbean deck was 9 levels. He heard a Code Alpha, then a Code Bravo, then 7 short and 1 long blast. This told him that he needed to report to his muster station.

He saw many people running outside, and ship security at the aft gangway. He also saw local police, and vessel security waving crewmembers off of the vessel.

His training included crowd management. He said that he took this training on one day, and it was basically a lecture explaining how to do it.
