Was on C deck to meet his friend because he was going to sign off. Was near 1039 cabin. Then he heard an explosion, then suddenly it was very dark, there was steam, he ran toward his cabin, C-1111, about 10 meters away. In his cabin, no steam, steam was over.

Then he felt his body was very hot, his skin was very itchy. He immediately went to the medical center on Viking Deck. He walked up via stair tower 3.

He had problems with his eyes and they gave him an eyewash, put cream on his ear because his skin was very out. He went out the vessel. The medical team told him to go onto the shore, on the shore a medical team saw him, the ambulance was there when he got to the shore.

They, medical team, put him on the ambulance, gave him O2, then they took him to the hospital. At the hospital, he waited a few minutes, the doctor checked him, gave him more cream, another eyewash, an injection.

They gave him a chest X-ray, he waited for an hour, the doctor looked at the X-ray, said that he was OK. Around 1430 a car took him back onboard.

After the hospital he was back on board and he saw the medical team onboard right away, and they sent him back to his back.

He has not resumed his duties because he has not signed off yet. He doesn't know when he will return, hasn't been scheduled yet.
