On the above said date at or about 1330hrs the Iowa Falls Police Department received numerous 911 calls reporting a plane crash at the Iowa Falls Municipal Airport. Chief KUHFUS, Sgt EMERSON, Ofc PROCHASKA and I immediately responded to the area. While en route I advised dispatch to page fire and EMS.

Upon arrival to the area (1332hrs) I could observe smoke coming from the southern area of the runway. I entered the airport and drove down the runway where I could see that the plane was fully engulfed in flames, I notified dispatch of same. I realized at that point that the aircraft had not made it to airport property but rather had gone down in an adjoining bean field. I advised dispatch to advise all rescue units to enter from Hwy 65.

I approached the scene on foot where I observed that Kevin KNUTSON expelled a fire extinguisher with little or no success. I was advised that witnessed had pulled the pilot from the wreckage prior to the plane being fully engulfed. I went to the location of the pilot and at approximately 1333hrs I pronounced the pilot dead. I was advised by Iowa Falls Airport Manager; Jane KNUTSON that the pilot was William KLEMME.

During this time the Iowa Falls Fire Department and American Medical Response (AMR) Ambulance arrived on scene. I advised EMS that the subject was deceased. IFFD extinguished the fire. I also advised dispatch to page the North Hardin County Emergency Squad to run traffic control on Hwy 65 due to the emergency vehicles in the area.

Trooper Lance BELOW (#214) arrived on scene. I requested that Trooper BELOW contact State Radio and request that the Federal Aviation Administration be contacted and dispatched to our location. Sgt EMERSON notified dispatch and requested that a Medical Examiner be contacted and dispatched to our location as well. Trooper BELOW left the scene to due death notification.

At that time I returned to my squad and obtained my camera. I began taking overall photographs of the scene as well as the body. I observed that the body was clothed in denim blue jeans, a button up plaid patterned blue and brown shirt, white colored underwear, a brown colored belt and white colored socks. There were no shoes on the victim however both shoes were located either in and/or near the wreckage. In examining the body I noted that there was severe trauma to the head, torso, arms and legs, with multiple compound fractures throughout the body. A black colored wallet was located near the wreckage that appeared to have fallen out of the pocket when witnesses drug KLEMME from the wreckage. Inside the wallet a State of Iowa issued drivers' license was located that confirmed the identity. Ofc PROCHASKA began obtaining written statements from two (2) witnesses identified as Roger BERNDT and Edwin KINNEY. During this

time MEI Lisa JOHNSON arrived on scene and conducted the medical examiner portion of the investigation.

In looking at the plane I was able to locate an identifier plate. The plate stated that the builder of the plane was; KLEMME William H. Model #CH-701, serial number 7-6580. The tail number on the plane was N701KC.

Based on witness statements it appears that KLEMMES' plane either stalled or slowed to a point where a wing dropped sending the plane nose down into the field. According to KINNEY they had radio contact with KLEMME prior to the plane crashing. It does not appear that any statements were made regarding mechanical issues with the plane.

Members of the Iowa Falls Police Department maintained security of the scene until members of the FAA arrived on scene. Once FAA arrived on scene they conducted their investigation. During this time Surl's Funeral Home arrived on scene and removed the body.

Contact was made with Iowa Falls Standard and they came to the scene and placed the plane wreckage on a rollback and transported the wreckage to KLEMMES' hangar per FAA. At this time a copy of this report is being forward Kyle THURSTON of the FAA. Nothing further to at this time. END...
