Narrative

Narrative:

At the above time and location 2601, 2621, 2660, 2260, 2206 and 2226 were toned to a plane crash NW of the runway. All units arrived on scene at about 1155 hrs. North Colorado Med Evac was performing CPR on 1 PT from the plane upon arrival. 2660 took Airport command and had 2206 assigned to fire suppression. 2601 was assigned to triage. 2621 assisted NCME with PT care and loading. NCME lifted off to DHMC at about 1214 hrs. Med Evac tx 1 PT to DHMC. 2226 tx emergent w/ 1 to EGSMC. 3 other souls on the plane received a field pronouncement. Dry chem was used for gasoline leak in right wing. No hazards were present when FD left scene.

Reports of smoke from plane prior to arrival. No smoke seen when FD arrived. After 2 PT's were transported, scene was secured by PD and turned over to FAA.

2601 turned the fuel to the off position for scene safety.
