MIDLAND PARADE PERMIT INFORMATION

(8 Pages)

Traffic: Pedestrians, ridden or herded animals, vehicles and other conveyances, either singly or together, while using any street for purposes of travel.

52.

Traffic control signal: Any device, whether manually, electrically or mechanically operated, by which traffic is alternately directed to stop and to proceed.

53.

Traffic division: The traffic division of the police department of the City.

54.

Traffic violations court: The corporation court of the City.

55.

Trailer: Every vehicle, with or without motive power, other than a pole trailer, designed for carrying persons or property and for being drawn by a motor vehicle and so constructed that no part of its weight rests upon the towing vehicle.

56.

Truck: Every motor vehicle designed, used or maintained primarily for the transportation of property.

57.

Truck-tractor: Every motor vehicle designed and used primarily for drawing other vehicles and not so constructed as to carry a load other than a part of the weight of the vehicle and load so drawn.

58.

Vehicle: Every device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, except devices moved by human power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.

59.

Yield signs: Signs bearing upon their faces the phrase "Yield Right-of-Way."

No procession, excepting the forces of the United States Army or Navy, the military forces of this state, and the forces of the police and fire departments, shall occupy, march or proceed along any street except in accordance with a

permit issued by the chief of police and such other regulations as are set forth in this Title which may apply. The above does not apply to funeral processions.
