C. REPORT CONTENT

This report contains additional information regarding a new Midland TX City Ordinance 10-1-2 "Permit Required for Special Events, addressing the issuance of all special events including a parade. The ordinance became effective on March 1, 2013.

Some of the key elements of the Ordinance are:

- All special event applications must be approved by the City manager
- Special event permits must be accompanied by a non-refundable \$50.00 fee and a refundable \$250 clean-up and damage fee
- Permits must be submitted at least 30 days prior to the event

- An event map must accompany the permit request
- The following city department heads must sign off on the permit and they must indicate any items necessary to provide security and\or safety needs on the approval form and the event organizers must provide evidence of a \$2 million insurance policy:
 - o City Attorney's Office
 - o Department of Engineering Services
 - Police Department
 - o Community Services Department
 - Health Department
 - Fire Department
 - o Solid Waste Management Department
- Event shall not exceed a speed of 10 miles per hour
- No special event permit shall be issued for any event proposed to cross over any railroad tracks.
