12. PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

- A All Level I, Level I-Specific, Level II and Level III personnel shall be given a vision examination to assure natural or corrected visual acuity as follows:
- (1) Near distance such that the individual is capable of reading with at least one eye the Jaeger 2 size letters at a distance of not less than 12 inches. The ability to perceive an Ortho-Rater minimum of 8 or similar test pattern is also acceptable.
 - (2) Color blindness test, the individual shall be capable of distinguishing contrast between colors using Ishihara color plates, or another method which gives equivalent results. Personnel deficient in visualizing certain colors shall only be restricted from performing examinations that require distinguishing between colors that he or she is deficient in.
 - (3) Each vision test shall be administered on a periodic basis, not to exceed two years by a qualified ophthalmologist, optometrist, medical doctor, medical technician or nurse.
 - (4) Results of the examinations shall be kept on file for the period of certification.
