MEDICAL RECORDS INFORMATION

The following medical information was extracted by Dr. Mitchell A. Garber, NTSB Medical Officer, from medical records maintained on the pilot by the FAA Aerospace Medical Certification Division:

10/9/2007 – The pilot’s most recent application for 3<sup>rd</sup> class Airman Medical Certificate indicated “Yes” in response to “Do You Currently Use Any Medication” and noted the use of only fexofenadine/pseudoephedrine, azelastine nasal spray, and minocycline. The application also noted “Yes” to “Hay fever or allergy” and indicated visits to health care providers for “adult acne” and “seasonal allergies.” No other medications or medical conditions were noted. “Total Pilot Time” was noted as 510 hours “To date” and 50 hours in the “Past 6 months.”
