**Persons on phone call:** Jeremy Mammen (Manager for safety and security for Aerosim Flight Academy) and Shawn Etcher (Self)

Mr. Mammen was asked if the pilot was injured. He stated that pilot was fine and there were no injuries

**Mr. Mammen was asked if he went to the accident location.** He stated he did along with two (2) mechanics. They flew another airplane over to the nearby airport and after they were complete on scene and talking with the FAA they flew back having time to talk to the pilot about what had happened.

Mr. Mammen was asked to describe what the pilot told him about what happened. He stated that the pilot was confident he was at Pilot Country airport, his intended destination, until he landed on the residential street and started impacting mailboxes. The student had utilized the GPS to locate and align with the runway, which is their standard operating policy. Until the airplane impacted mailboxes the pilot was certain he was at the airport.

Mr. Mammen was asked if there were any mechanical anomalies requiring the airplane to land on the street. He stated no there were none the student just made a mistake.

Mr. Mammen was asked if the student was writing a statement and was to be debriefed. He stated that yes the student is writing a statement and has been debriefed.

Mr. Mammen was explained the 6120 requirement and that a written statement from the student is required. He stated he understood and provided me with an email address in order to send the 6120 form to.
