## Subject: ERA09FA133, Milton, FL, N428DC accident

Mr. Darlington was an employee of the Anderson Municipal Airport fixed base operator (FBO). Following is a summary of a telephone interview with him.

According to Mr. Darlington, the airplane was fueled with 57 gallons of Jet A fuel, which "topped off the tanks," on January 11, 2009, at 1501 CST.

Dr. Darlington stated that the pilot told him he was going to Destin, Florida, to visit his father. He additionally stated he would return the following day.
