**QUESTION 2**

Provide the actual/estimated volume of gas released and dollar value for the lost gas; actual/estimated cost for repairs to PG&E pipeline/facility and to the City of San Bruno; property damage to affected structures and an explanation of Emergency Relief payments and payments to Governmental entities as referenced in NTSB\_071-001.

**ANSWER 2**

- Estimated volume of gas released: 47,600 MCF.
- Dollar Value of lost gas: \$263,000 (at approximately \$0.55 / therm cost of procurement).
- Estimated cost for repairs to the pipeline facility: The estimated cost of repairs to the pipeline facility is \$13,500,000. Please note that PG&E will not be repairing the section of L-132 in the area of the incident. PG&E is still evaluating options for gas supply on the peninsula.
- Estimated cost for repairs to the City of San Bruno: PG&E has made a lump sum payment to the City of San Bruno in the amount of \$3 million and made payments totaling \$887,669.45 to the City of San Bruno for fire, police, security and other services. PG&E has also contributed \$12 million to a trust which will be used to advance funds on behalf of the City of San Bruno or to reimburse the City for any costs incurred by the City in connection with the accident, as more fully described in the trust agreement.
- Property damage to affected structures: As set forth in NTSB\_071-001, in 2010, PG&E accrued \$220 million for estimated third-party claims including property damage claims, damage to infrastructure, personal injury and other damage claims.
- Emergency relief payments of \$8,534,615.68 referenced in NTSB\_071-001 is for emergency relief checks, immediate needs checks, gift cards and direct payments to vendors for living expenses, hotel, car rental payments and other cash payments unrelated to the release of any claims.

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- Payment of \$18,911,484.45 to Government Entities (as referenced in NTSB\_071-001) is for the following:
  - \$3 million lump sum payment to the City of San Bruno.
  - \$12 million to a trust which will be used to advance funds on behalf of the City of San Bruno.
  - \$887,669.45 for fire, police, security and other services paid to the City of San Bruno.
  - \$3,023,815.00 for fire, police, security and other services paid to other governmental entities other than the City of San Bruno.
