Dear Mr. García:

Thank you for your May 18, 2018, letter regarding the fatal accident involving a Cessna 208B, Costa Rica registration TI BEI, that occurred on December 31, 2017, shortly after takeoff from the Islita Airport, Punta Islita, Costa Rica. You request to delegate the investigation to the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB).

In accordance with Annex 13 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation, the NTSB accepts your delegation of this accident investigation. To complete it, we will need the following information and request that it be provided at your earliest convenience:

- 1. A copy of the Nature Air operations specifications
- 2. Pilot records for both pilots from the Dirección General de Aviación Civil (DGAC)
- 3. Autopsy and toxicology reports on the pilots
- 4. DGAC surveillance records of the pilots and operator for at least the past 3 years
- 5. History of accidents at Islita Airport
- 6. Flight records for the pilot (from July 2017 through December 2017) from the accident operator
- 7. Flight records from the previous 2 years for the pilot from his previous employer (SANSA)
- 8. SANSA policy on takeoff toward mountains at Islita Airport (We were told that SANSA no longer allowed its pilots to depart toward the mountains.)
- 9. NTSB Form 6120.1 completed by accident operator, if possible.
