Narrative:

The following is a synopsis of the information provided by the duty officer this date:

At the request of NTSB Duty Officer Fox, the local airport manager and a sheriff deputy examined the airplane fuel tank. The airplane had a single fuel tank positioned behind the crew seats. The fuel tank filler cap was not installed on the tank at the time of examination. The airplane was resting nose down due to the collapsed nose landing gear. The airplane tail was pushed down to get the airplane into a level attitude. With the airplane level, the level of fuel in the tank was measured by dipping a broom stick into the tank. The sheriff deputy reported that the fuel tank had about 2" of fuel remaining, or about 1/2 gallon.
