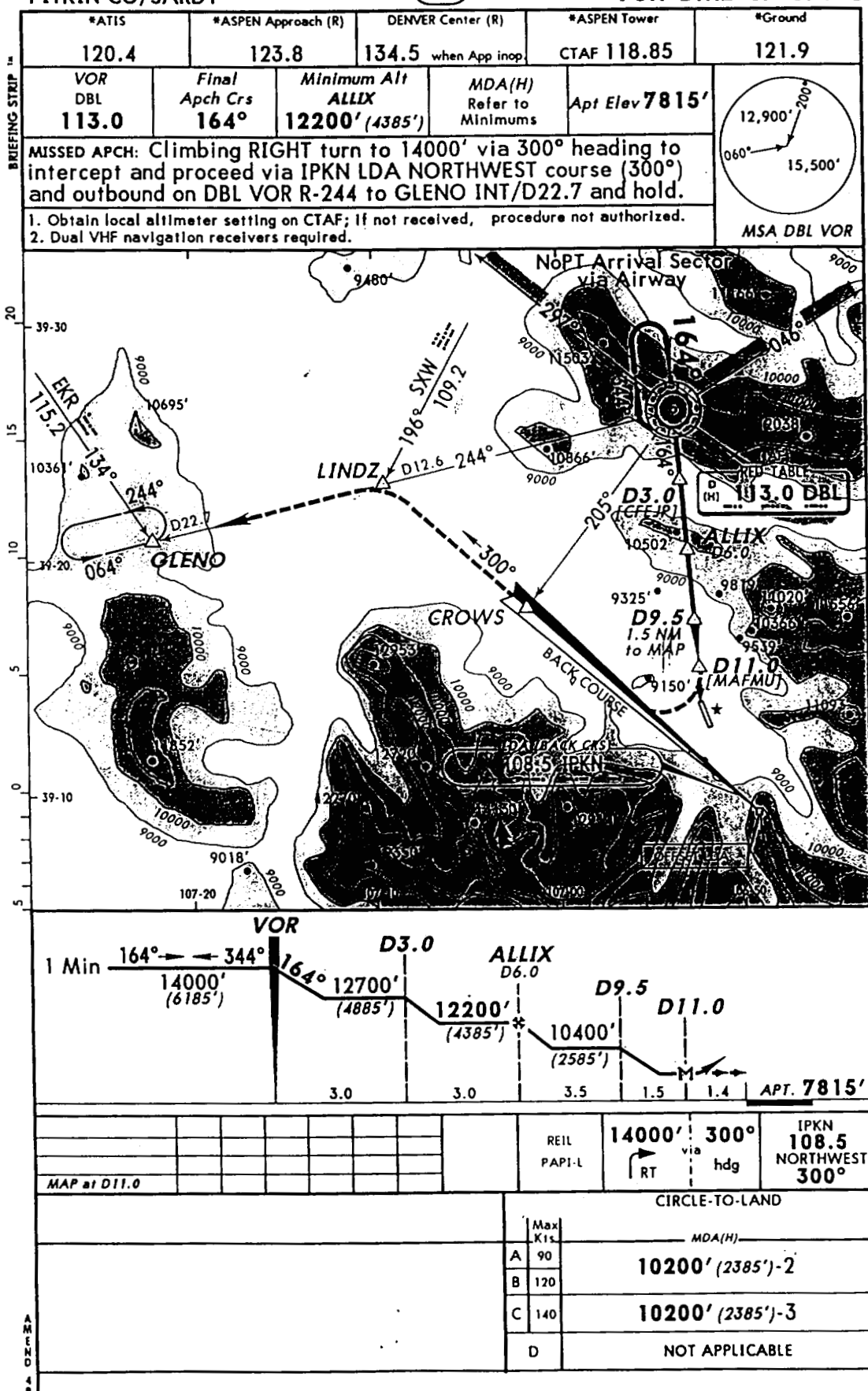

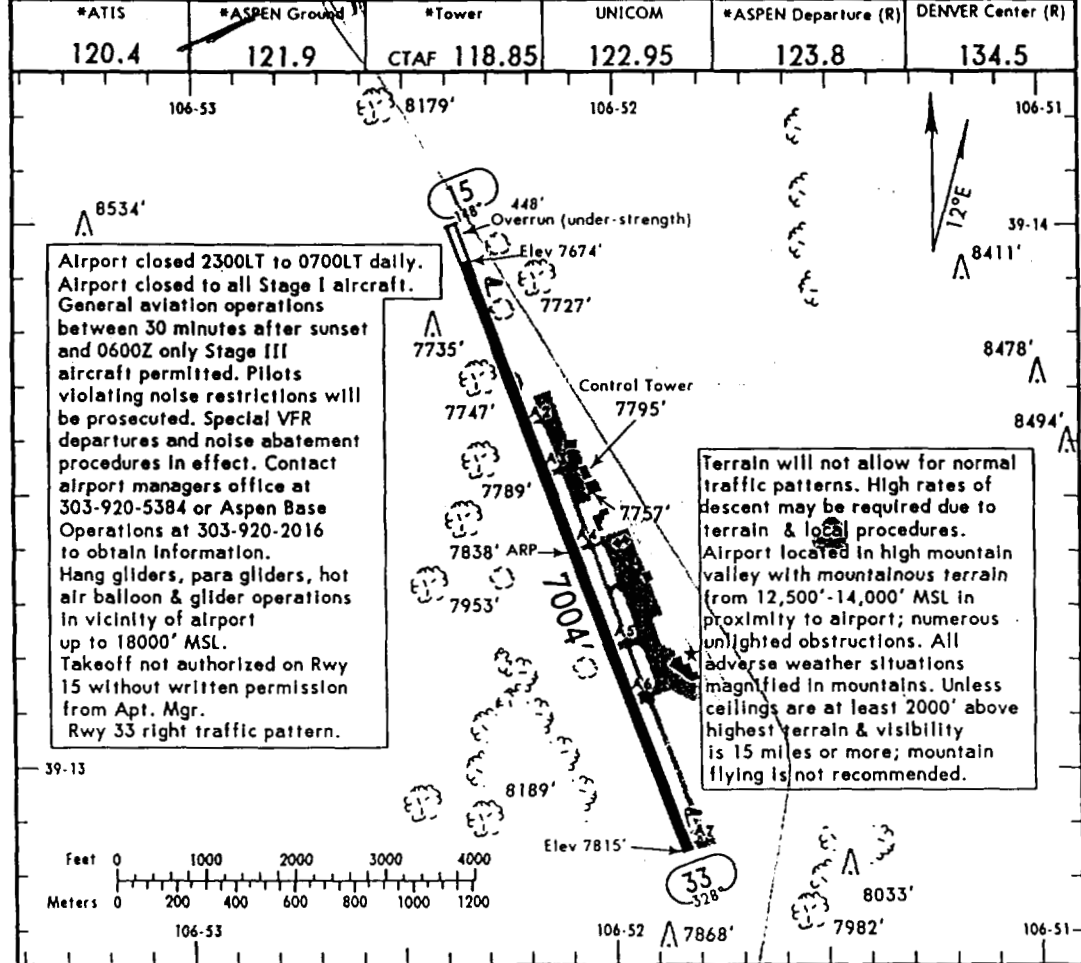

Airport closed 2300LT to 0700LT daily. Airport closed to all Stage I aircraft. General aviation operations between 30 minutes after sunset and 0600Z only Stage III aircraft permitted. Pilots violating noise restrictions will be prosecuted. Special VFR departures and noise abatement procedures in effect. Contact airport managers office at 303-920-5384 or Aspen Base Operations at 303-920-2016 to obtain information. Hang gliders, para gliders, hot air balloon & glider operations in vicinity of airport up to 18000' MSL. Takeoff not authorized on Rwy 15 without written permission from Apt. Mgr. Rwy 33 right traffic pattern.

Terrain will not allow for normal traffic patterns. High rates of descent may be required due to terrain & local procedures. Airport located in high mountain valley with mountainous terrain from 12,500'-14,000' MSL in proximity to airport; numerous unlighted obstructions. All adverse weather situations magnified in mountains. Unless ceilings are at least 2000' above highest terrain & visibility is 15 miles or more; mountain flying is not recommended.
