Additionally, any and all records pertaining to the inclusion and dissemination of the Carson's
Flight Manual Supplement No. 8 that was in effect at the time of the accident, including, but not
limited to memorandums, correspondence and e-mail.

This information shall be released to the National Transportation Safety Board in accordance with Title 49 of the United States Code Section 1113 which provides such authority.
