Level 3 (Red Warning)	<p>Situation requiring immediate action. Level 2 (Amber Caution)	<p>Situation requiring pilot awareness but no immediate action, such as a system failure having no direct consequence on flight safety (e.g., blue hydraulic system low pressure)</p>	<p>Single chime (SC)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> MASTER CAUT light illuminates amber Caution message on E/WD Applicable system page appears on S/D
Level 1 (Amber Caution)	<p>Situation requiring pilot monitoring such as system failure leading to a loss of redundancy or system degradation (e.g., FCDC fault)</p>	<p>None</p>	<p>Caution message on E/WD generally without a procedure</p>
