Minot East Dispatcher: Yes sir, Dan here, Minot East Dispatcher, DS 91. KO Sub; got a 4934 that says

their train is everywhere and on fire. I don't...they said they had to go and ran. I

don't know what's on fire to be honest with you.

Service Interruption Desk: 4934, well were at?

Minot East Dispatcher: Their around MP, CP 30 and 28.4; so between MP 30 and 28.4 on Main number

Service Interruption Desk: Ah do we have a derailment or what?

Minot East Dispatcher: I guess so. I, I... he just said emergency, emergency, along with the train is on

fire, we are everywhere. He said the train was everywhere so I am assuming we

have a derailment it's a Key Train.

Service Interruption Desk: Alright, okay we'll get right on it.

Minot East Dispatcher: Ok you need a train symbol?

Service Interruption Desk: Ah, yea go ahead.

Minot East Dispatcher: U F, Y, N, H, A, Y, 4, 05T.

Service Interruption Desk: If he can possibly get it, see if you can kind of narrow down this ah location.

Minot East Dispatcher: I will, I have a maintainer out there close to the area to, I'll talk to him. (Phone

conversation ends).

Minot East Dispatcher: Minot East Dispatcher 4934, over. Minot; Minot East Dispatcher signal

maintainer, over.

14:17:52 seconds – December 30, 2013:

Minot East Dispatcher (2nd shift dispatcher on radio): 6990, you guys thinking you can cut and run and just leave the cars.

Minot East Dispatcher (1st shift dispatcher on phone): Hello. Is this Pete with the train derailed?

Unknown: Excuse me?

Minot East Dispatcher: Who is this?

Unknown: Eric.

Minot East Dispatcher: I am sorry, I got the wrong number. Is this 701-527-8468?

Unknown: Nope this is 8498.

Minot East Dispatcher: Sorry, thanks a lot bye-bye.

Minot East Dispatcher Hello is this Pete with the train at Casselton.

Conductor Riepl: Yes I am.

Minot East Dispatcher: Hey, I know you're, this is Dan the Minot East Dispatcher.

Conductor Riepl: Yea we derailed big time.

Minot East Dispatcher: Okay that is what I understand. Do you know where you derailed at exactly by

chance?

Conductor Riepl: What milepost is this? We are right at the switch.

Minot East Dispatcher: Are you far enough, first of all are you far enough away from the train to be, are

you a safe distance away from the train?

Minot East Dispatcher: Okay, is anyone hurt right now?

Engineer Thompson: No, our train...we're shaken up but we're good.

Minot East Dispatcher: Okay.

Engineer Thompson: It looks like the train on Main Track 1 picked or something at the switch there.

Minot East Dispatcher: Okay I heard the maintainer talking on that, okay.

Engineer Thompson: Yea and they picked it or something it's all torn apart. We had an approach

medium at Casselton, we came through their dust storm and I saw their car

lying across the track.

Minot East Dispatcher: Okay and you hit the car? You hit the car on Main 1?

Engineer Thompson: Oh yea. Our engines are completely engulfed.

Minot East Dispatcher: Okay.

Engineer Thompson: And fire, I mean we need to get farther away.

Minot East Dispatcher: Oh I understand.

Engineer Thompson: We haven't blown up yet.

Minot East Dispatcher: Okay, I just, just try to get as much information as I can for the local authorities.

If you need to call me back that's fine.

Engineer Thompson: They need fire trucks and they need a lot of them.

Minot East Dispatcher: Okay, I will let them know and you're right at milepost, right at the switch at

Casselton, right in there, around 28

Engineer Thompson: Yea we're walking in to Casselton, I think I see Ron Davidsons truck.

Minot East Dispatcher: Okay, alright, I'm, I'm just trying to find out what I can. If you need anything

you know let me know but I just want to make sure you're safe; I'll let you go.

Engineer Thompson: Just to let someone laugh a little, I need a new IPAD.

Minot East Dispatcher: (Laughter) Yea, I'm sure they'll get right on that. (Laughter) Okay Boyd.

Engineer Thompson: We're good, we're good sir. We're good.

Minot East Dispatcher: Hey, you're... Okay I'll let out guys know down here, thank you much.

Engineer Thompson: My conductor, he does, he's covered in smoke.

Minot East Dispatcher: Okay.

Engineer Thompson: And I am to a little bit but I think...

Minot East Dispatcher: Where are you headed to? Do you want us to send an ambulance to you guys

to have him looked at?

Engineer Thompson: No I don't want a god dang ambulance, I'll ride with somebody.

Minot East Dispatcher: Okay, well I didn't know if he needed anything or not so.

Engineer Thompson: No, he said his lungs hurt, I mean it's as black as smoke as you'd ever see it.
