1911:09	pilot minutes out, r	"Bellingham tower, Mooney 123JN is 14 miles south with KILO, about 5 equest entrance for landing." (strong voice)
1911:39	LC directly south,	"Mooney 123JN, Bellingham Tower, are you more to the southeast, or southwest?"
1911:49	pilot	"We're almost due south, just coming up the south side of the bay."
1911:50	LC final."	"123JN make straight in approach for runway 34 and report a 3 mile
1912:07	pilot	"Cleared for runway 34 approach, will report 3 mile final, JN."
1920:41	LC	"Mooney 123JN, update position and altitude."
