The following is a summary of a conversation that occurred with a Zenith Aircraft representative.

The following is a summary:

- If the nose landing gear bungee fails, the rudder would remain steerable.
- If the nose landing gear was stuck or lodged into place due to a hard landing, the rudder would also become lodged into place.
- There is no official service life that Zenith Aircraft publishes for nose landing gear bungees. The service life will vary due to a variety of factor such as engine type installed.
